learning environment safe and welcoming for everyone. Right now, the faculty handbook seems to be the place with a checklist of items required for syllabus inclusion, but it does not mention Title IX. Canvas has a Title IX section built in in the menu, but we believe that having an accessible language on syllabus and faculty intentionally calling attention to the language and resources is important to bring these existing procedures to a meaningful implementation. We would like the Senate's input on the syllabus template language, and Senate's support to make Title IX a universal feature for every instructor's syllabus.

- **6.** District and college governance structures, as related to faculty roles
- 7. Faculty roles and involvement in accreditation processes, including self-study and annual reports
- **8.** Policies for faculty professional development activities
- **9.** Processes for program review
- 10. Processes for institutional planning and budget development
- **11.** Other academic and professional matters as are mutually agreed upon between the governing board and the academic senate
