### 3.1 Review Recent Commission Actions

Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges (ACCJC) received one letter from U.S. Department of Education and one letter from National Advisory Committee on Institutional Quality and Integrity (NACIQI) that ACCJC had violated federal standards. ACCJC found to have lack of educators or academic representatives on both the visiting teams and appeal panels. ACCJC is given 12 months to comply with the federal standards.

### 3.2 Standard I: Review and Discussion

ACCJC Standard I handouts were distributed. Members were given 10 minutes to read all 14 points under Standard 1C – Institutional Integrity. See Appendix I for details.

Standard 1C, Institutional Integrity, is a new section. Discussions were focusing on 1C9: “Faculty distinguish between personal conviction and professionally accepted views in a discipline. They present

data and information fairly and objectively.” It appears not to be an easy point to provide evidence while maintaining the Academic Freedom. Further detail to be discussed.
