

Research Brief:

Fall 2009 Child Development Center Students – Characteristics and Enrollments

Just a quick set of bullets on the Fall 2009 Child Development Center students:

- Of the 49 parents, 42 are currently enrolled as Skyline students (two of these enrolled students are also Skyline Staff); an additional student was enrolled at CSM.
- 35 of the 42 students are women.
- The population of CDC students / parents is very diverse: 12 of the students are Hispanic, Filipino – 5, White – 5, Asian – 4, Black – 3, Pacific Islander – 3, Native American – 1, Other / Decline to state – 9.
- Not surprisingly, the population is centralized in the cities around Skyline; 11 student/parents are from Daly City, 11 from South San Francisco, 7 from San Bruno, 5 from Pacifica, 2 from San Francisco, and 1 each from Belmont, Burlingame, Foster City, Palo Alto, and Redwood City.
- The 42 students are taking a total of 367 units, or an average of 8.7 units per student.
- 10 of the students are taking 0 to 5.9 units, 16 are taking 6.0 to 11.9 units, and 16 are taking 12 or more units.
- The 42 students are currently estimated to produce 20.38 FTES in Fall 2009.
- The 42 students account for 153 course enrollments in Fall 2009, or an average of 3.8 courses per student.
- These course enrollments are distributed throughout the curriculum:
 - ECE – 14
 - FITN, LSKL – 12
 - CAOT, COSM - 11
 - MATH – 10
 - ENGL – 9
 - ADMJ, COUN, ESOL, PSYC – 6
 - BUS, HIST, MUS – 5
 - SPCH – 4
 - BIOL, COOP, PHYS – 3
 - ARBC, CHEM, FCS, HSCI, LEGL, PHIL – 2
 - ACTG, ANTH, AUTO, CRER, DSKL, FILM, INDV, P.E., SOCI, SPAN - 1
