Recap of last month's meeting:

- 1. EPC discussed the role of the Educational Policy Committee in student disciplinary hearings. It was decided that the responsibility for providing panel representatives for such hearings did not inherently reside with the EPC. The Committee suggested that the process could be made easier by having the VPSS send out a request to the deans for panel volunteers at the beginning of every academic year. The deans would then identify one person from each division to serve on an "as-needed" basis for one year, much like the way a grand jury operates. Steve forwarded the Committee's decision and its suggestion to VPSS Dr. Joi Blake who replied, thanking the EPC for the recommendation and that she would follow up. *Is there any follow-up discussion on this item*?
- 2. EPC discussed the feasibility of establishing its own Educational Policy Constitution and By-Laws document. It was decided that since the Committee was under the direction of the Skyline College Academic Senate, and of both the College and the District (all of which are guided by policy rules and constitutional provisions), adding yet another level of rules would be unnecessary and confusing, and thus was not approved. *Is there any follow-up discussion on this item*?
