## **How to Apply for Financial Aid**

- For U.S. Citizens or Permanent Legal Residents submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- For AB540 or Undocumented Students submit a California Dream Act Application (CADAA)
- Only submit one of the two applications either the FAFSA or CADAA
- All Foster Youth students need to complete a CHAFEE grant application
