Community Service Activities Form

Community service is a requirement for completion of the Honors Transfer Program. The aim of the requirement is to encourage good citizenship and leadership virtues among our honors students. Requirements:

A minimum of **16 hours** of substantive community service are required for completion of the program. Submit a form for each event or portion of work completed.

Appropriate community service projects may be drawn from Skyline College service projects, the Phi Theta Kappa Honors Society (which has ongoing projects that you can volunteer to participate in), and of course from the many local community organizations. Students may select alternative activities or service projects provided that they are associated with a recognized community organization.
