







Also, I would have liked to see the instructors helping the students to find and assess their own sources (after the lecture/activity) in order to give the students more hands-on experience searching and assessing sources. This could be really effective if the students were placed in small groups and asked to find a source on the research topic assigned in their Engl 100 class, and then to assess it using the checklist/criteria, and then maybe present it to the group and have the instructor intervene/guide as they do.
