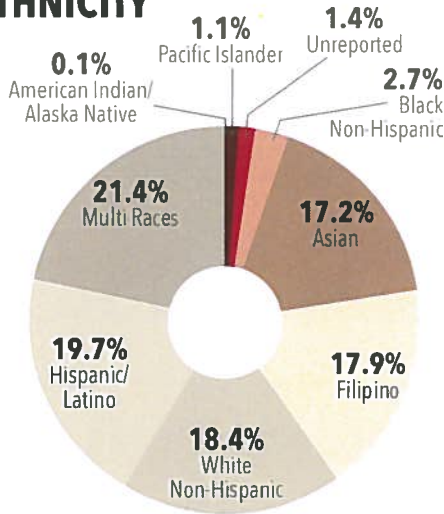

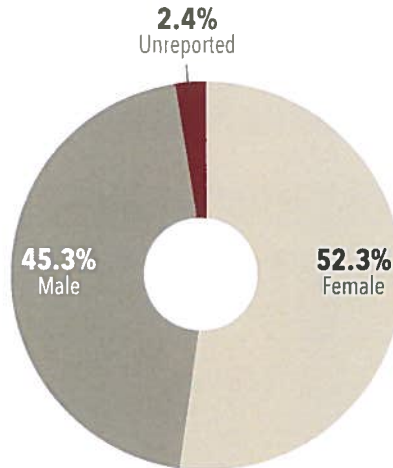

## FALL 2018 STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS

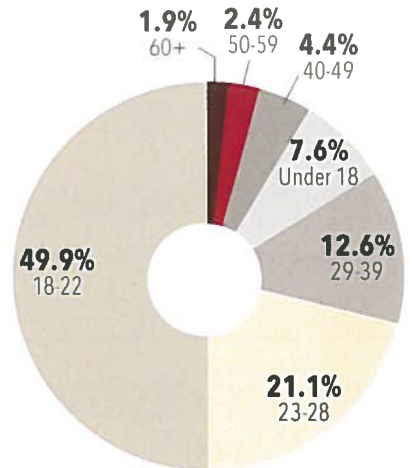
### ETHNICITY



### GENDER

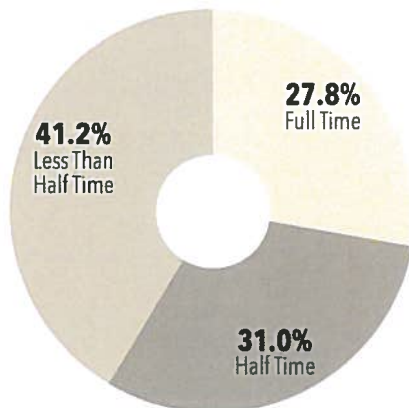
