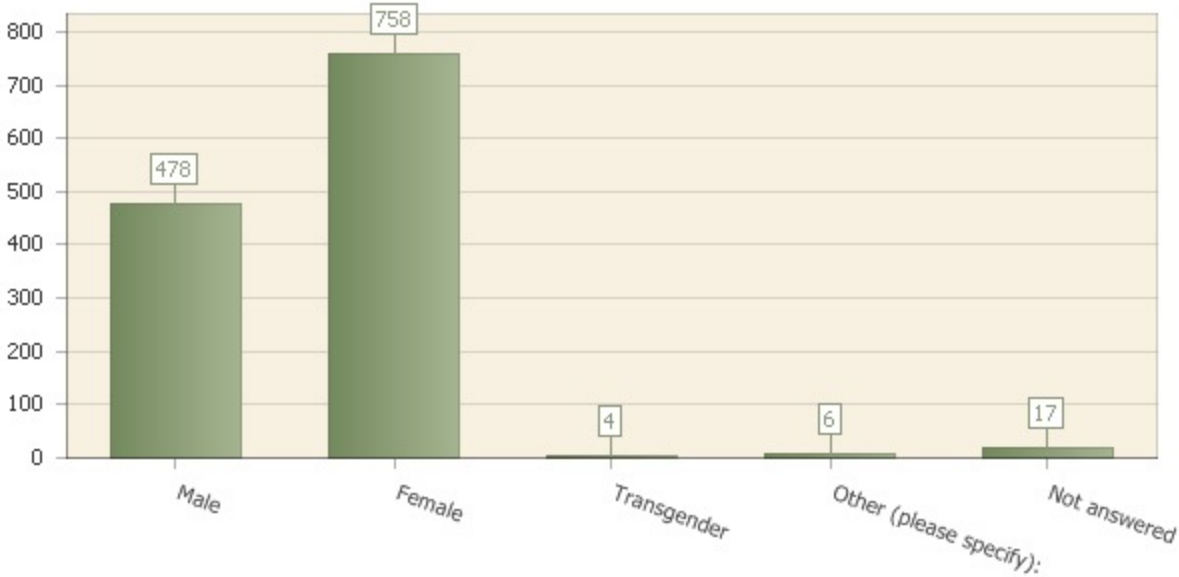

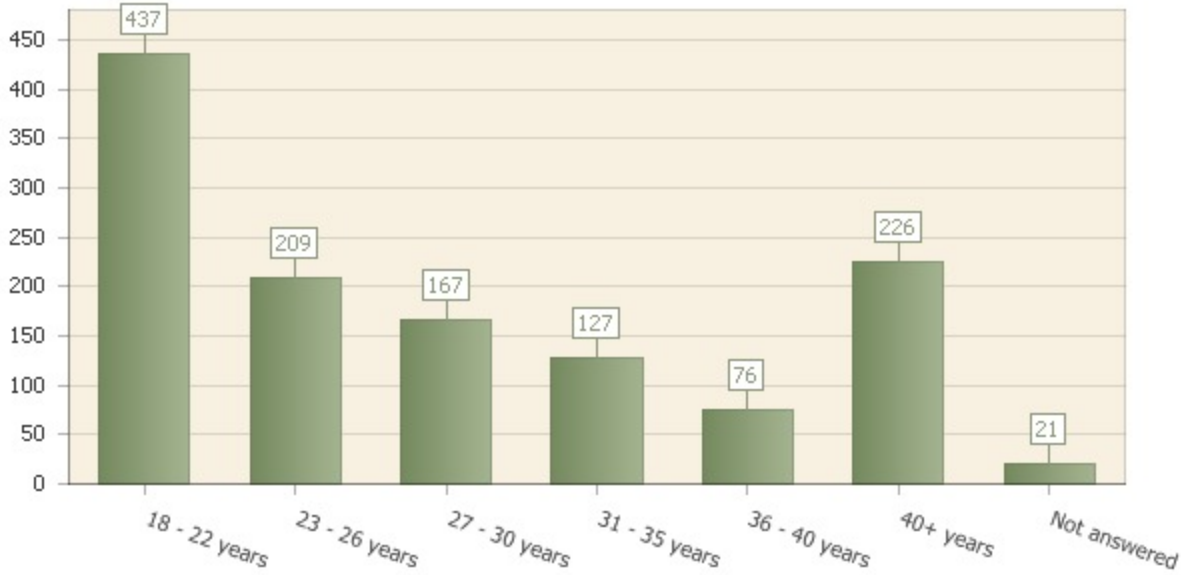

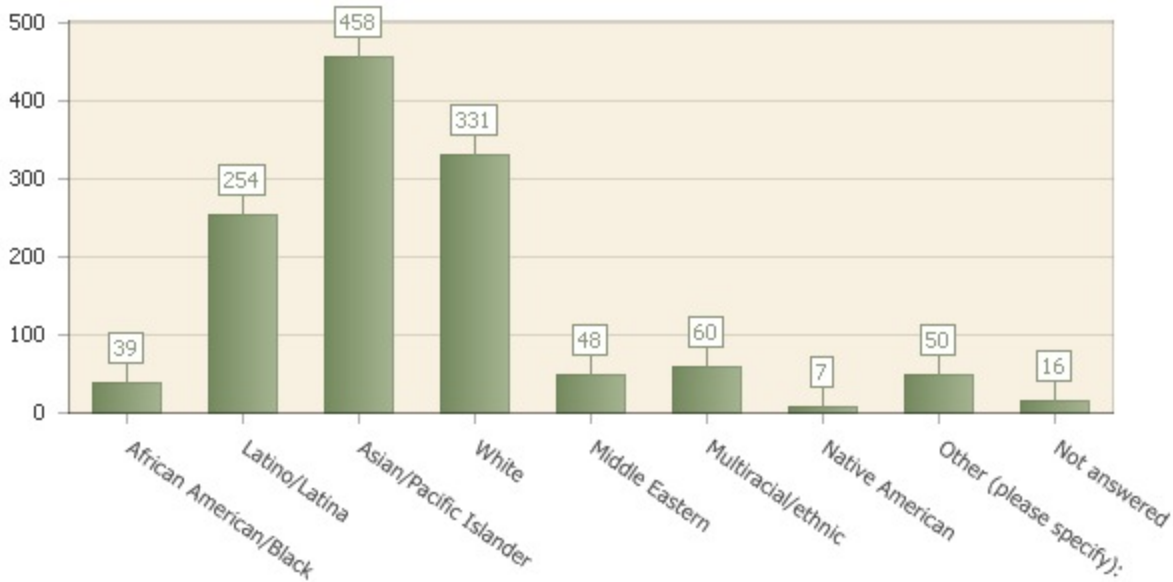

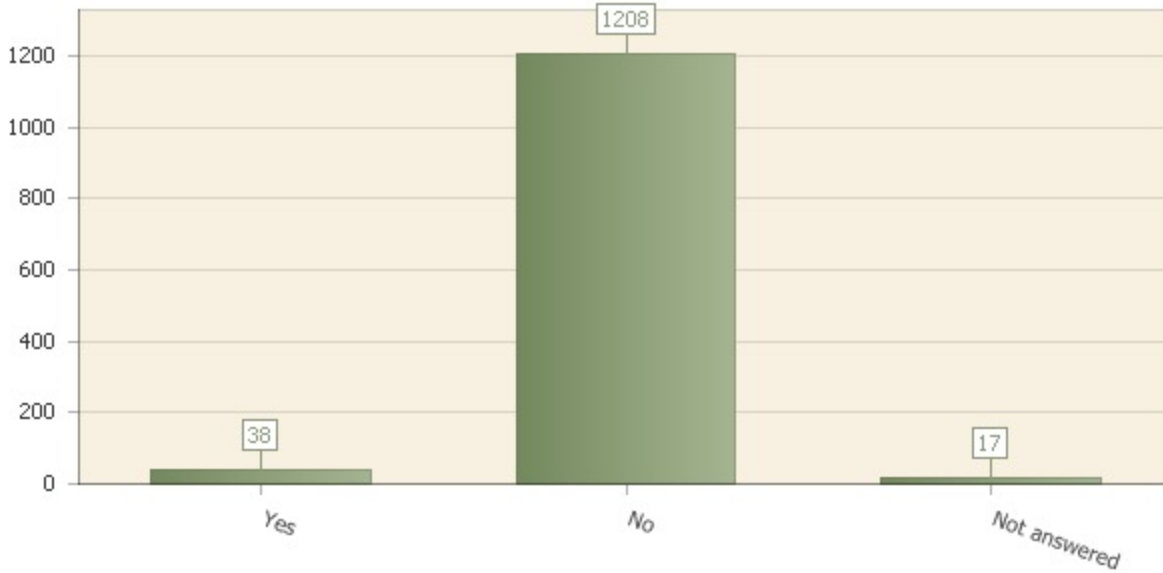

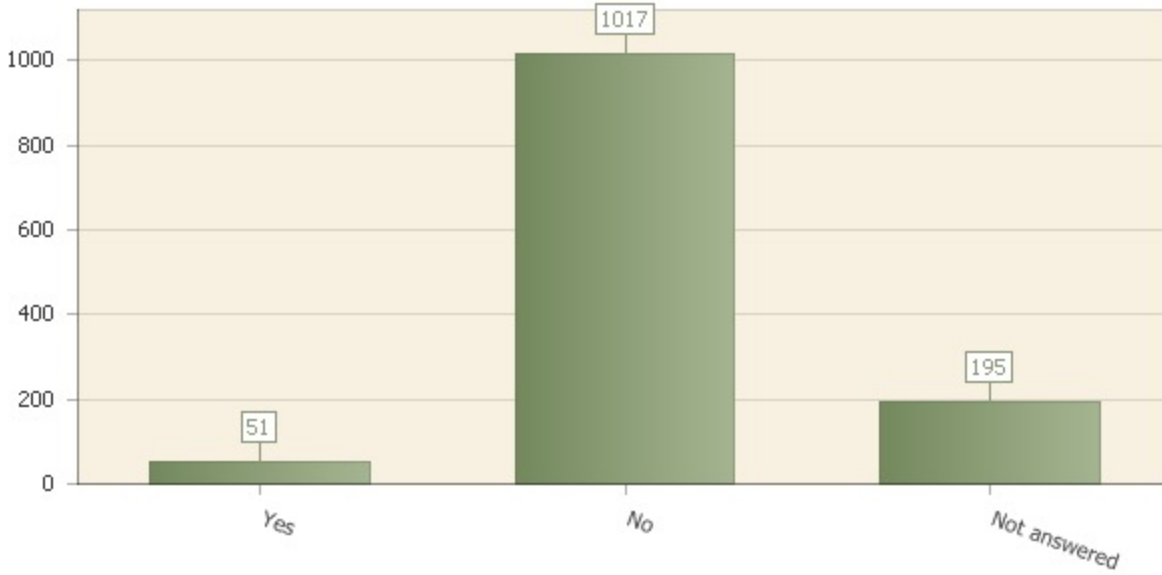

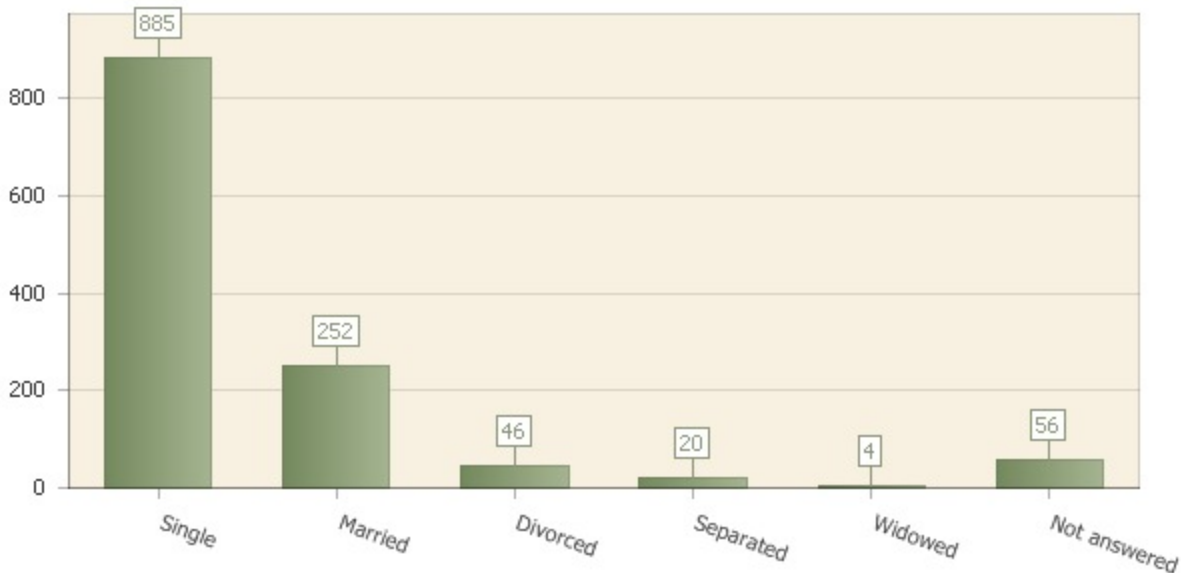

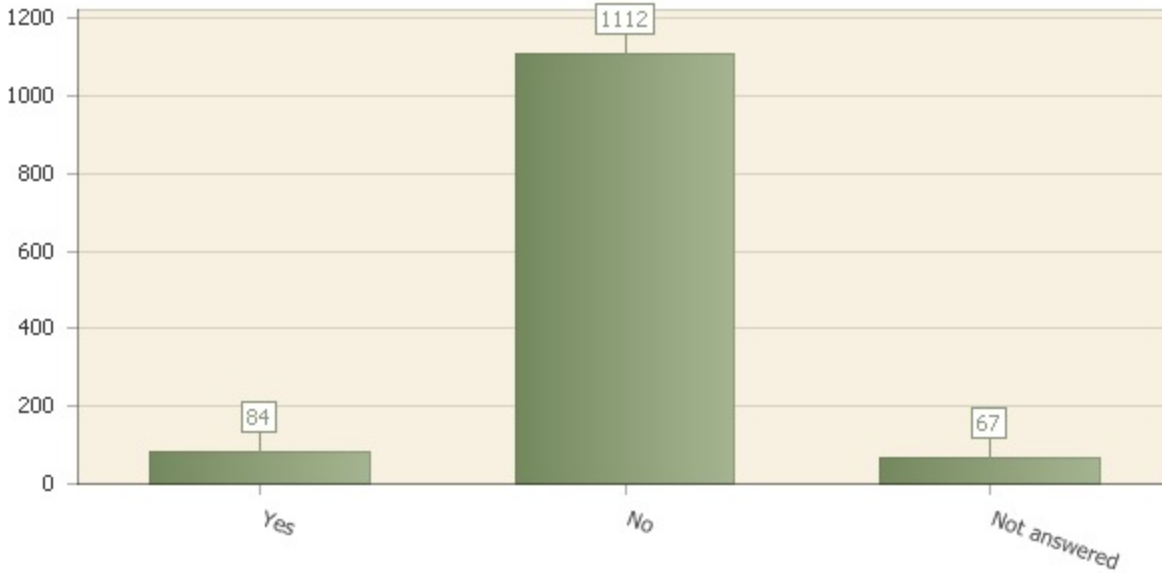

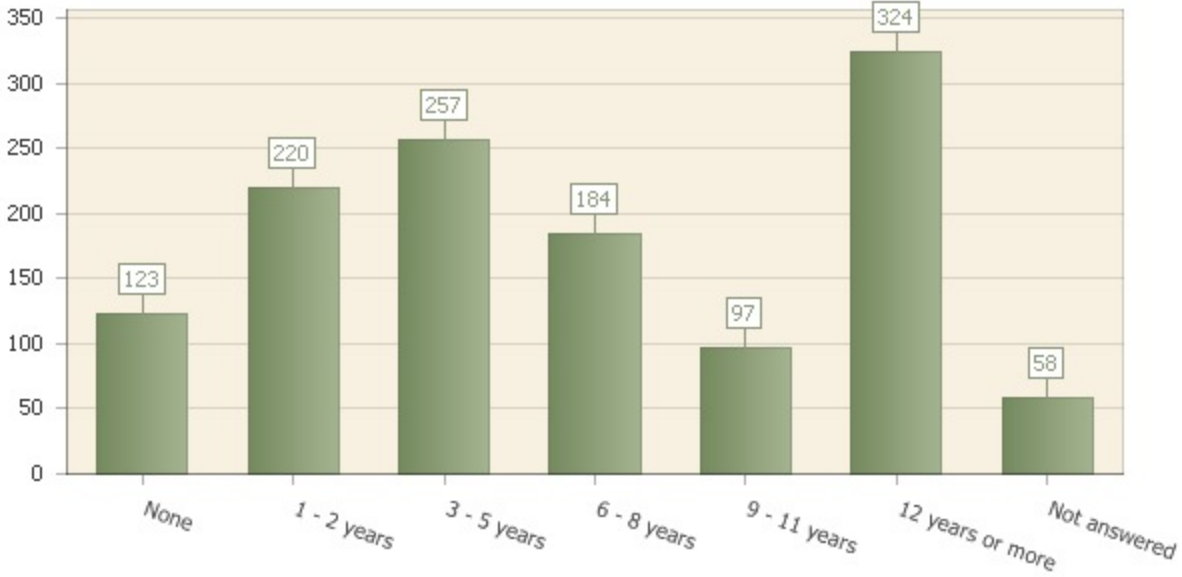

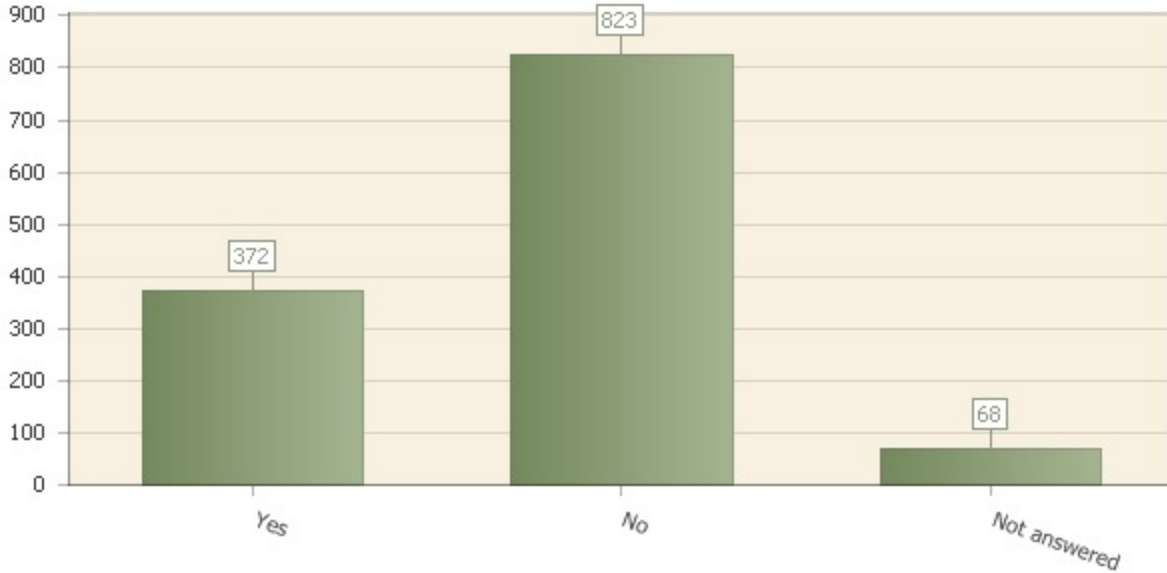

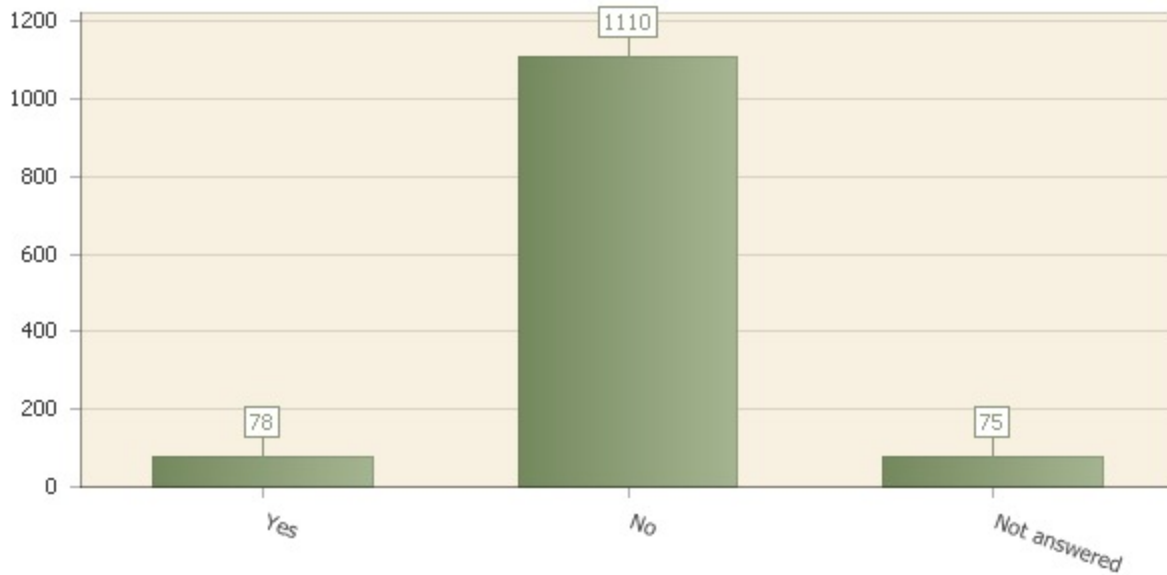

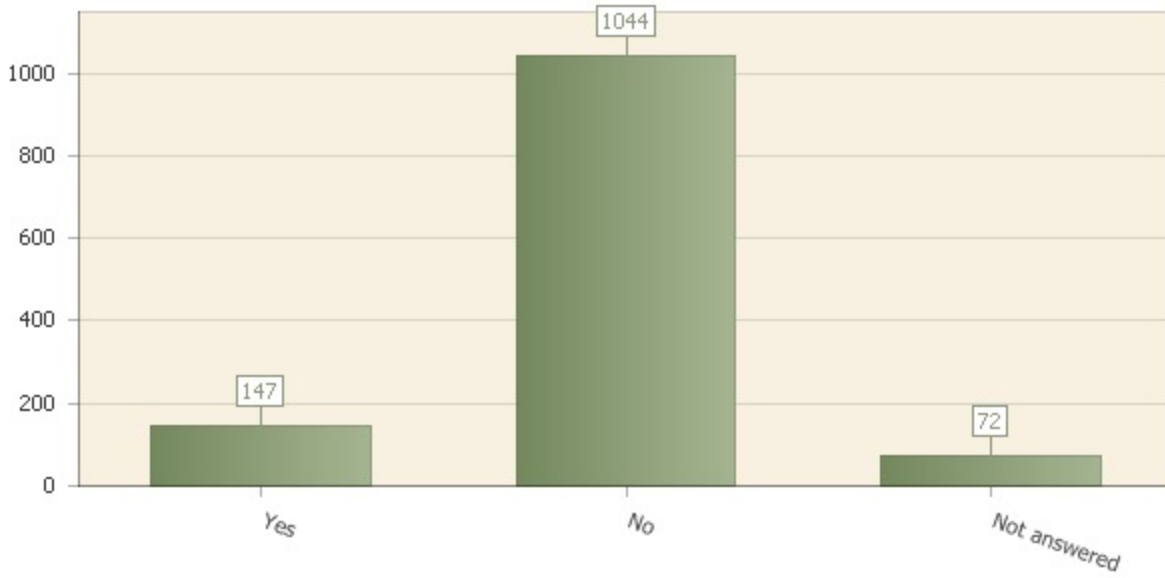
Have you spent more than one year outside of the job market in the last two years?



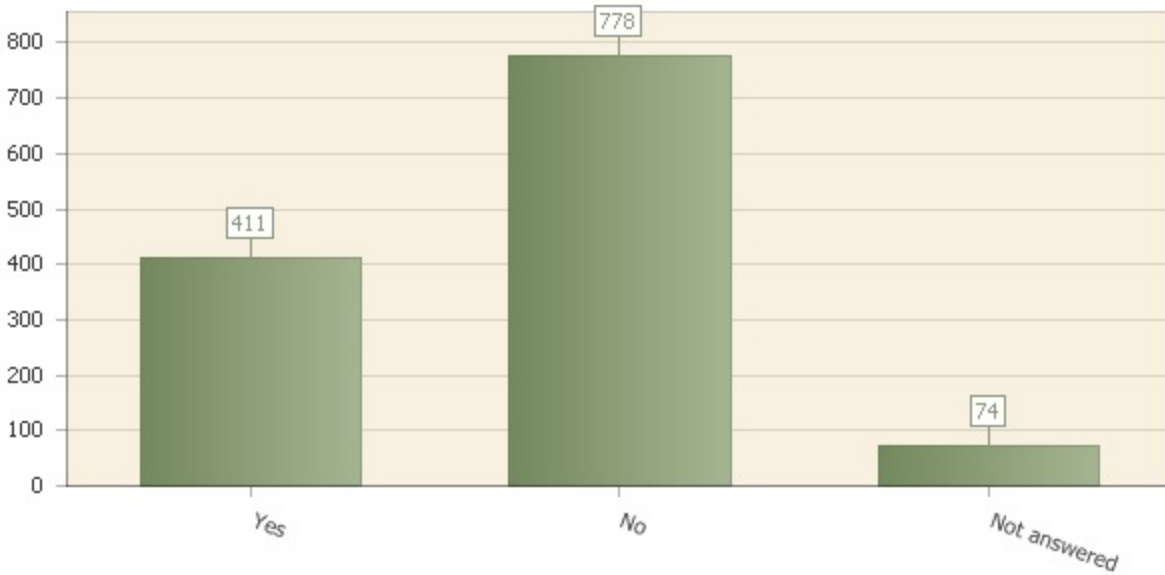
Have you been dependent on the public assistance of a relative (who is no longer able to support you)?



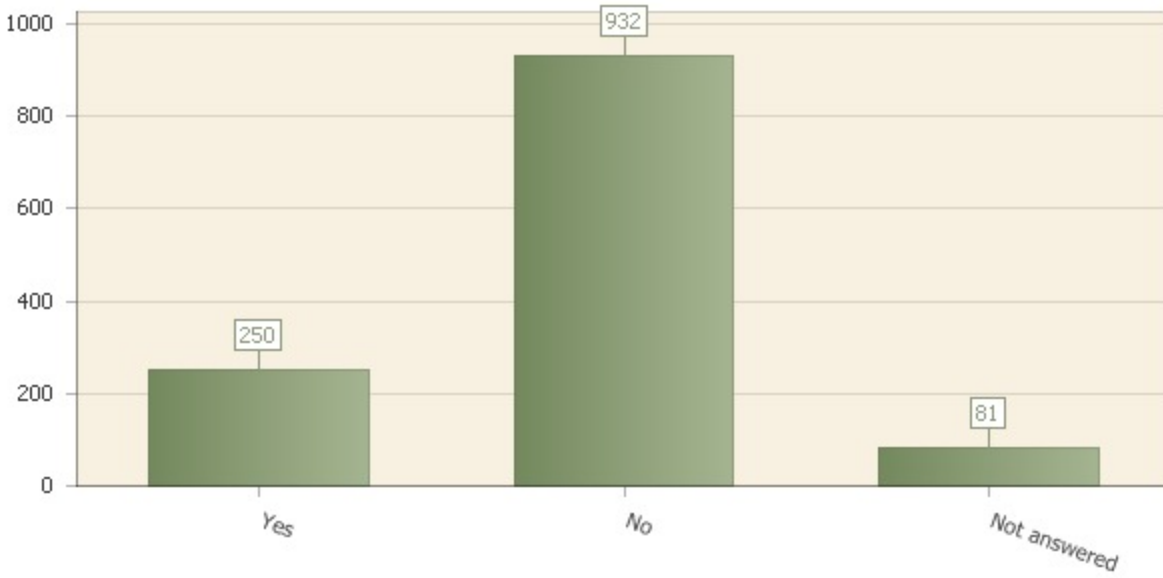

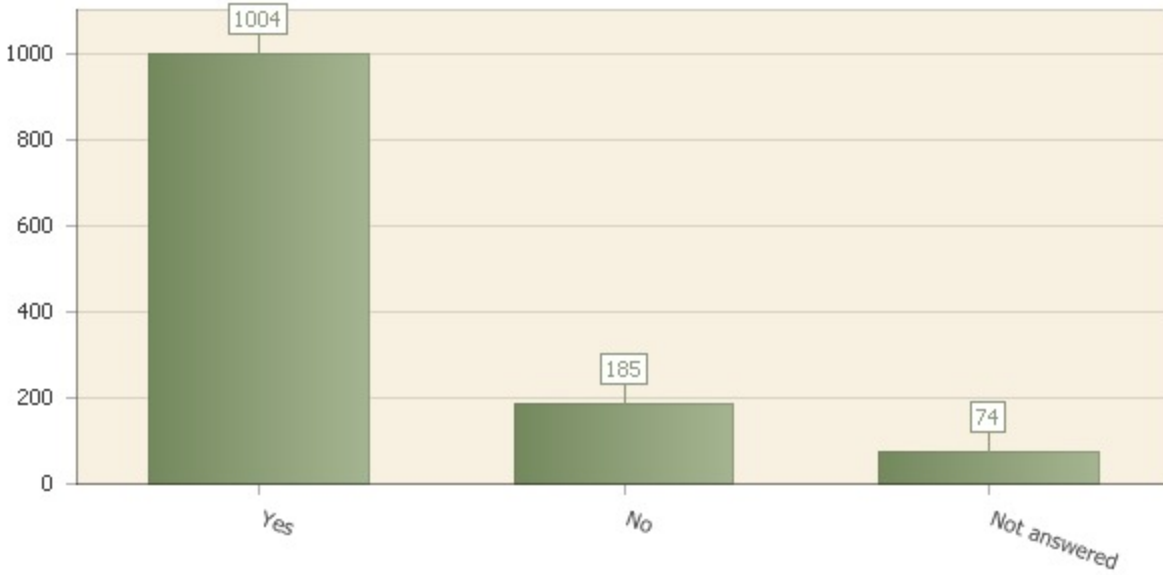

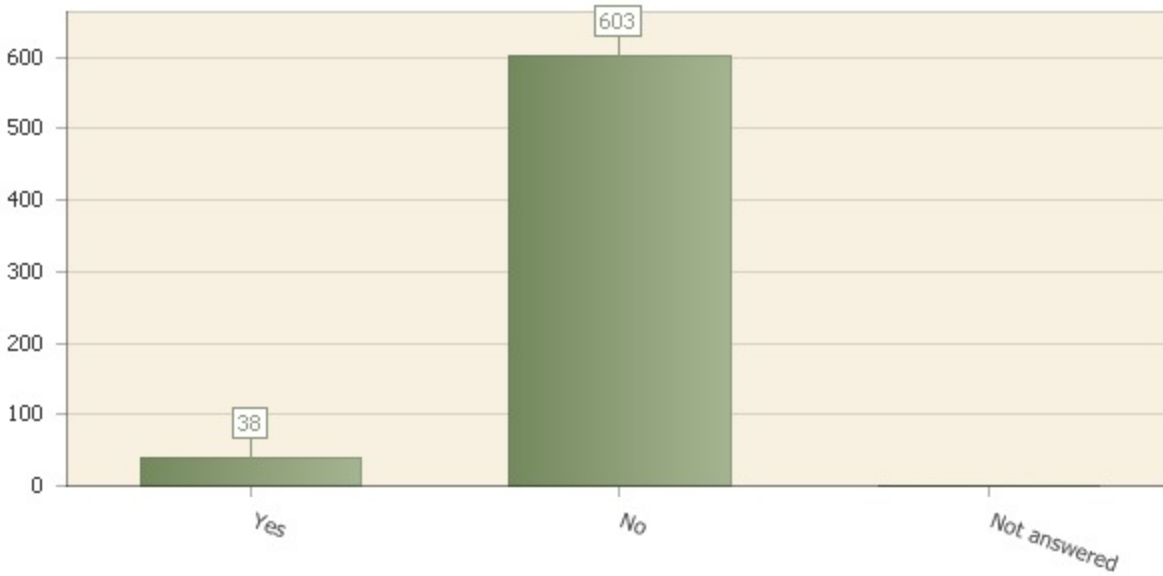
If you are not currently receiving assistance, do you require assistance from Disabled Students Programs & Services (DSPS)?

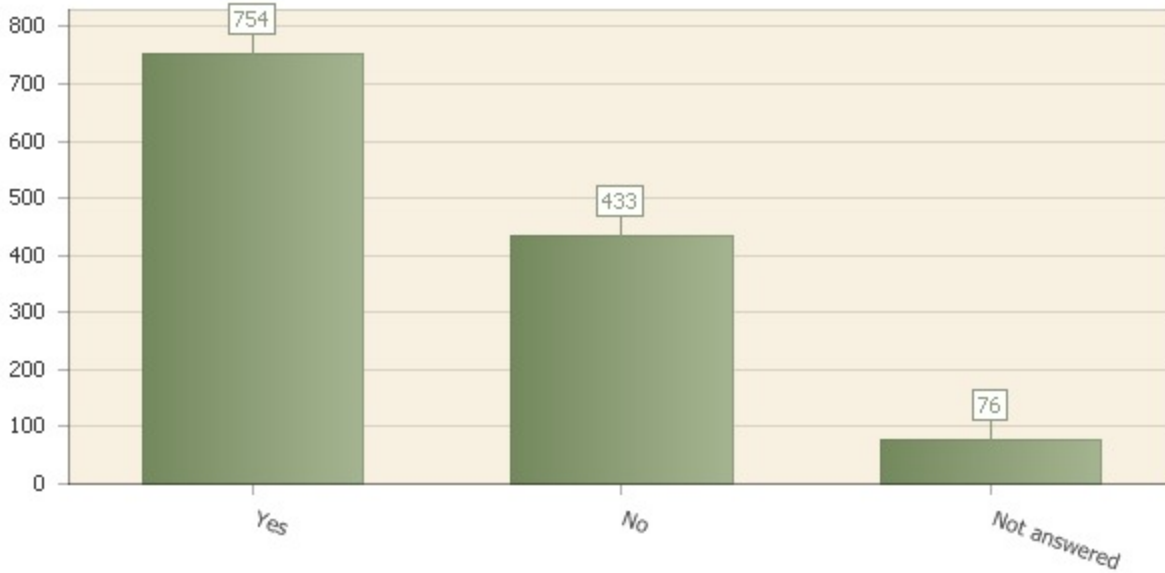

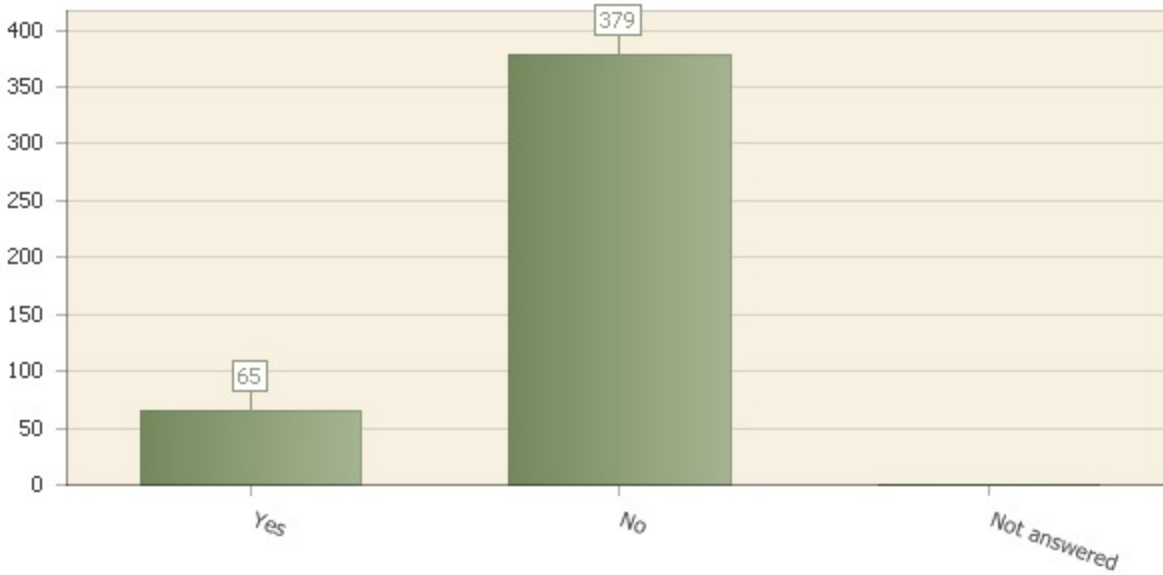
If English is not your first language are you receiving assistance in English?

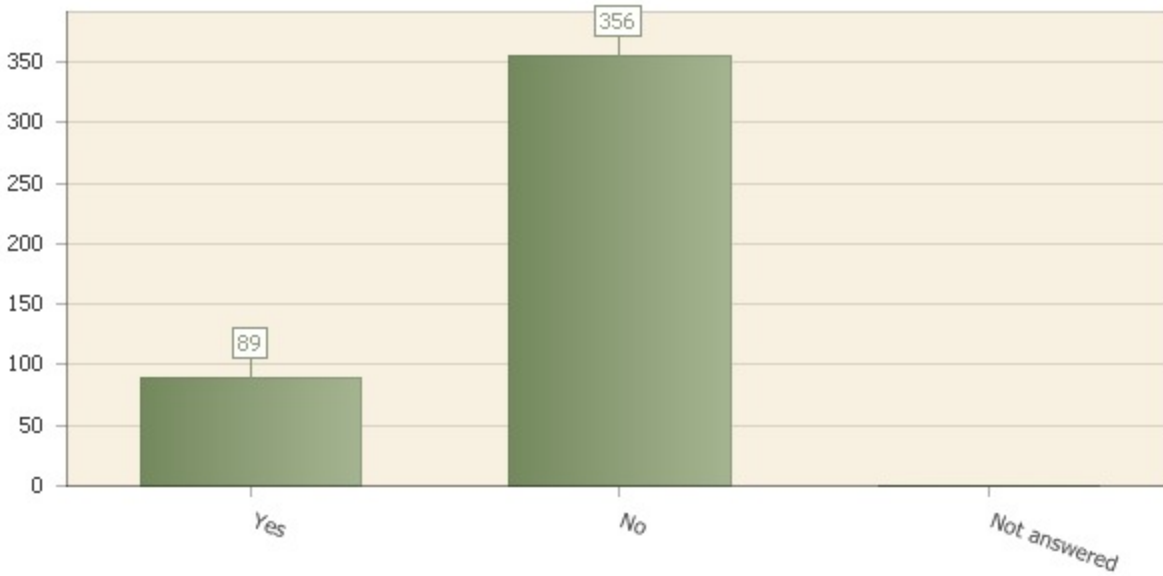
If English is not your first language and you are not currently receiving assistance, would you like to receive assistance in English?

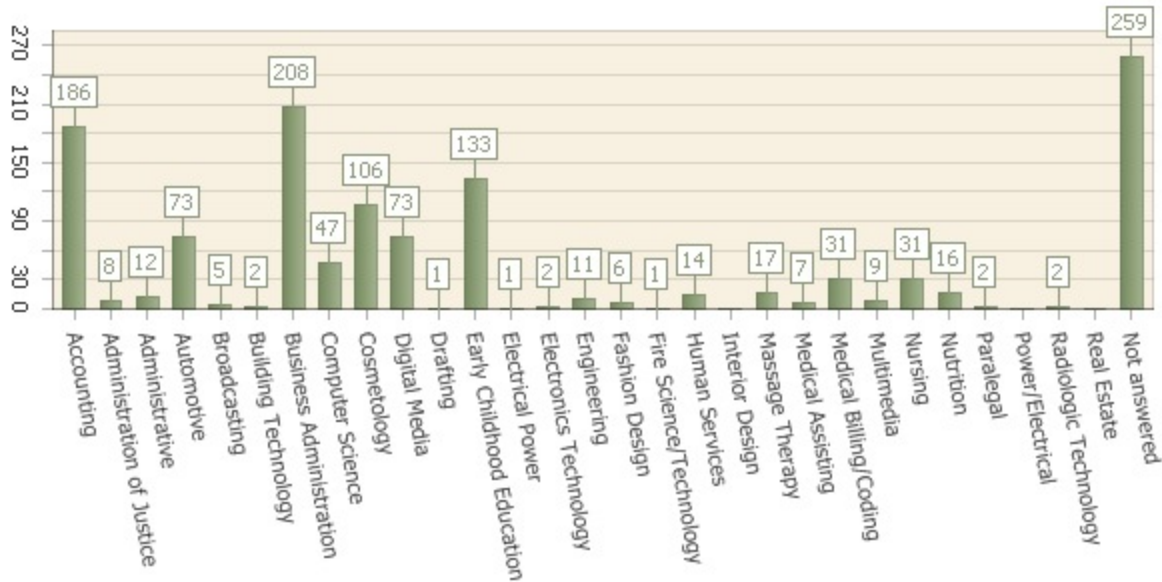
