The following courses are currently being accepted as fulfilling lower division major preparation requirements at Holy Names University. These are not to be confused with general education requirements. For a list of those please refer to the official **HNU-Skyline College Articulation Agreement** to determine what classes will fulfill Holy Names University General Education requirements.

Students registered in the generic BSN program are expected to earn at least a B- in the required science courses (Anatomy, Physiology, Chemistry, Biology, and Microbiology). If a grade of C+ or lower is earned, a student may repeat one class one time in order to earn a B- or better grade. A second grade of C+ or lower in a science class will result in disqualification from the program.

Once admitted to the program, the student is expected to complete all courses throughout the program at HNU, which means courses may not be taken elsewhere and transferred to HNU after admission.
