

## Associate in Arts in Anthropology for Transfer Degree

---

Transfer degrees are designed to provide students a clear pathway to a CSU major and baccalaureate degree. Students may choose to complete an Associate in Arts for Transfer Degree (AA-T) or Associate in Science for Transfer Degree (AS-T).

### This degree is intended for students who:

- Are interested in completing an Associate Degree prior to transferring to a California State University (CSU) campus
- Plan to complete a bachelor's degree in a similar major at a CSU campus. For the Associate in Arts Degree in Anthropology, the similar major at *most* CSUs is Anthropology.

### What are the benefits for students earning an AA-T Degree?

- Guaranteed admissions with junior standing to the CSU system, but not a particular campus or major
- Priority admissions consideration to a student's local CSU campus or to a program that is deemed similar to a student's community college major (*This priority does not guarantee admission to specific majors or campuses*)
- Required to complete no more than 60 units after transfer to earn a bachelor's degree.

### Who may *not* benefit from earning this degree?

This degree *may* not be the best option for students intending to transfer to a particular college or university that is *not* part of the CSU system. Students should consult with a Skyline College counselor for further information on university admissions and transfer requirements.

### To earn the AA-T Degree in Anthropology, you must:

- Complete the CSU General Education or the IGETC (CSU) requirements
- Complete the required major requirements (18 – 20 units) – see below
- Complete 60 CSU transfer units (this includes general education requirements, major requirements, and elective units)
- Obtain a minimum grade point average of 2.0.

### Please Note:

- A grade of “C” or better is required for each course applied to the major
- 9 – 19 major course units may be double counted to apply to meet general education requirements
- This degree does **not** require the Skyline Associate Degree Requirements.
