Greetings Karen,

Since Fall 2018, SSCA Division has changed our Division meeting model to include faculty workshops to inform teaching/learning and presentations about campus-wide initiatives (Meta Majors, Thematic GE, and ZTC to name a few of the presentations we've hosted). We include adjuncts in our meetings (attendance is optional per the contract), but we do pay adjunct who attend our Division Meetings to encourage them to be engaged and up-to-date on the innovations and initiatives at Skyline College.

Additionally, we include adjuncts in our SLOs coaching, professional development (we are sending a Psychology adjunct to the Equity Institute with the Skyline Team) and we have an Art adjunct participating in the Equity Training Series. I include adjunct faculty in the professional development and course development process by sharing funding opportunities and we have adjunct faculty applying with proposals for ZTC and POOD (online course conversation for the development of online degrees...I think it is called something like this??). We also have Psychology adjunct faculty participating in the development of the NOW program. We have several who have expertise in online education and are playing a key role in the development of our program.

Finally, we have started a collaboration with CSM's Project Change (Serving Incarcerated Students Program) and this semester we have our first faculty member teaching in the San Mateo Juvenile Hall. This faculty was selected for this position because of his experience teaching in the prison system and is an adjunct. He is now serving on the Project Change Community of Practice, was a panelist at our last FLEX Day during the 'Serving Incarcerated Students' session, and also presented at our March SSCA Division Meeting.

We also conduct evaluations to ensure academic standards and each semester I send an email to all faculty encouraging participation in the CCTL Online Training Certification Program and many have participated in the past year.
