## Application Process

Students are admitted into the program once a year only, for each Fall (beginning in August) semester. The application period is open January 15 - June 1.

Approximately 40 students will be admitted to the program each year. Selection is based on criteria approved by the Skyline College Administration and consistent with state regulations (see application instructions). **Contact the program** for further information on the Respiratory Care Baccalaureate Program. Student registration is cohort model based, requiring courses to be completed in sequence patterning. Credit may be given for previous coursework.

## Student Entrance Eligibility

Who is eligible to apply?

- Students currently enrolled in AS Respiratory Care program at Skyline College and intend to continue to BS Respiratory Care program

OR

- New graduates from other programs who have completed an accredited Respiratory Care program equivalent to an AS in Respiratory Care and are California licensure eligible

OR

- Respiratory Care Practitioners who have completed an accredited Respiratory Care program equivalent to an AS in Respiratory Care and are California licensure eligible

AND

- Completed minimum 30 units of the CSU General Education pattern

### Application is open until seats are filled.

*Note: Students wishing to apply for the Respiratory Care Bachelor's Degree Program will need to follow the three steps for application as listed below. Students may only apply during the active application cycle.*

**STEP 1: Enroll at Skyline College**

**STEP 2: Complete Respiratory Care Bachelor's Degree Online Application**

**STEP 3: Submit Three Letters of Recommendation**
