## Participant Experience

All of these workshops are hosted on Friday afternoons from 12:00 PM- 3:00PM. Lunch will be provided. The first hour and a half will be the talk/workshop by the designated presenter. The last half of the session is the group discussion and planning on how to apply the new information to their work. The final session will consist of presentations sharing the planned application of the practices discussed during the training.

## ETS 2017 Pilot Program

The inaugural ETS was held from January 27-May 12th. Workshops were facilitated by scholars/education practitioners and covered a myriad of topics including: Whiteness and Racism, Unconscious Bias, Culturally Relevant Pedagogy, Critical Pedagogy and Pin@y Student Success. There was a cohort of 21 Skyline College staff, faculty and administrators that engaged in a dynamic professional development experience to increase their knowledge and skills around cultural fluency, pedagogy and educational equity. All participants presented their posters, curricula and mission, vision and values statements at the ETS Recognition Luncheon on May 12th.
