Hi Joe & Ricardo,

I heard back from Yoseph and went ahead and made changes directly to the attached document. I am attaching the latest version and pulling Avi & Yoseph into the email thread in case they have any feedback.

The changes:

- We no longer using Sophos PureMessage - With Office 365, we now have a built-in multiple spam filters through Exchange Online Protection (EOP) service, so our email is protected from the moment we receive first incoming message.
- We no longer use Snort to detect and control unauthorized network intrusion because our new firewall handles this now
- We no longer use OpenDNS to prevent faculty, staff, and students who use the District's network from being redirected to known malicious websites because our new firewall handles this now
- Our number of instructional servers has expanded so for now I just removed the number "7" and said that ITS maintains instructional servers.
- As of August 2018, Skyline was upgraded from a 1GB network connection to 10GB

Here's some more info from Yoseph regarding CENIC connection and network backbone:

- Skyline College's Internet connection was upgraded to 10Gig circuit in August 2018: Preceding with projects such as campus firewall, core switch and router upgrades has prepared Skyline College to upgrade all of its campus Internet circuits connections from 1Gig to Corporation for Network Initiatives in California (CENIC) 10 Gigabits backbone with redundant (10Gig) connection. The upgrade allows Skyline College to connect to CENIC's high-speed research and education network, which is 10 times faster than previous connection.
