Respiratory Care Bachelors Degree at Skyline College

Beginning fall 2016, Skyline College offers a Respiratory Care Bachelors Degree. Students are admitted by special application, once a year, in the fall term.

Completion of a minimum 30 units of CSU General Education prior to program start is part of the required eligibility to the Respiratory Care Bachelors Degree.

Students admitted to Skyline College's Respiratory Care Bachelors Degree, with coursework completed at colleges and universities outside San Mateo County Community College District (Cañada College, College of San Mateo or Skyline College), should submit official transcripts from all previously attended colleges and universities to Skyline College's Office of Admissions and Records.

They should then request an official transcript evaluation of that coursework from Transcript Evaluation Service (TES) within the first weeks of their first term of enrollment at Skyline College.

Completed lower-division associate degree-applicable coursework is reviewed, analyzed, applied, as appropriate, to CSU General Education requirement for Skyline College's Respiratory Care Bachelors Degree.

Transcript Evaluation requests are submitted through the student's WebSMART account. The evaluation is then viewable in Degree Works™ and serves as the official response from the district.
