

## Participatory Governance Evaluation Process Team Meeting, Thursday, May 23, 2019

### I. Initial Discussion/ questions/ brainstorming session:

- Primary Goal for this team is to re-establish a process to evaluate participatory governance
- We are not required to follow the exact PG evaluation process described in the 2013 Handbook; The CGC bylaws state that an evaluation must be completed every 6 years, but the process for the evaluation is not specified
- Need to examine the results of the Nov-Dec 2018 Participatory Governance Survey
  - Initial results:
    - 47 faculty, 27 staff, 6 administrators responded
    - Survey did not ask faculty status; cannot view adjunct vs. full-time faculty responses
    - Do we want to try for a better response rate with a new survey in the fall including modified questions?
    - Should the survey include students within the ASSC?
  - Compare the results between the previous survey from 6 yrs ago to the current
  - Evaluate the open-ended questions more closely
- Topics to consider in PG review process:
  - What are the reporting structures for committees?
  - Who charges the committees?
  - How is accountability being addressed and who provides oversight?
  - Should committee members be surveyed about their experience at the end of each academic year?
- Should a community forum be part of the review process?

### II. At start of fall term:

- Report out on where we are regarding the evaluation process of shared governance and what initial concerns we have about participatory governance
- A “chair” of chairs: Someone to manage all the chairs of the committees
- Establish tasks, timeline, and deadlines, long-term goals
- Recommend a process for every committee to take on or address the following questions:
  - What is your charge?
  - Are you meeting the charge?
  - Does the charge meet the college goal?
