

DAYTIME AUTOMOTIVE TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM STUDENT APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCEDURES

NOTE: This application is <u>NOT</u> necessary for students wishing to register in AUTO 710 or AUTO 711. Students wishing to take the classes mentioned above need only use the Skyline College Application for Admission, available online at <u>www.skylinecollege.edu/automotive/apply.php</u>. Please note that Skyline College Application is only good for 2 years, if you have not attended any classes within 2 years at any of our District Colleges, then you would need to reapply.

Application for the Daytime Automotive Technology Program must be received by April 15 for the Fall semester and by November 15 for the Spring semester. The application and all documents must be sent & received to the Automotive Department Office, Building 8, Room 8208. Applications received after the deadline will be assigned the next available number on a waiting list according to the date received. Applicants are responsible for submitting the following:

PREREQUISITE: AUTOMOTIVE FUNDAMENTAL EDUCATION OR WORK EXPERIENCE

Documented proof of prior automotive experiences. All statements MUST be substantiated by attached documents of verification (a transcript or letter from employer on business letterhead). Such documentation may come from one or more of the following:

One semester of AUTO 710 or AUTO 711 at Skyline College (equivalency from another community college would be evaluated for transfer credits, otherwise AUTO 710 Credit by Exam will be required to be accepted into the program) with a grade of "C" or higher (Submit a copy of your final grade report with your application, a letter from your instructor would be beneficial)

OR

One year of high school automotive training with grade of "C" or higher (verified by official transcript), a letter of recommendation from your automotive instructor would be beneficial. If accepted into the program an Automotive Fundamentals Credit by Exam (AUTO 710) with a passing score will be required in order for us to issue certificates of achievement. There is a Credit by Exam exception for students who pass both dual enrollment courses AUTO 509.1 and 509.2.

OR

One year of full-time related work experience by submitting a letter with this application from your employer on business letterhead specifying employment dates and duties. The depth of work experience will be evaluated by the admission team. An Automotive Fundamentals Credit by Exam (AUTO 710) with a passing score may be required in order to be accepted into the program. The AUTO 710 Credit by Exam will be required in order to issue any certificates of achievement.

MATH

Students must demonstrate Math proficiency in one of the following ways:

Successful completion of one year of a U.S. high school Elementary Algebra course. The final course in the term must be completed with a grade of "C" or better (Submit a copy of your high school transcript with the application)

OR

 Successful completion of a college Elementary Algebra, or higher level courses, with a grade of "C" or better (Submit a copy of your college transcript with the application)

OR

Demonstrated placement at the Intermediate Algebra level (MATH 120) or higher, on the Skyline College MATH Placement Test (Submit a copy of your placement result with the application)

ENGLISH

Students must demonstrate English proficiency in one of the following ways:

Successful completion of one year of a U.S. high school senior English course. The final course in the term must be completed with a grade of "C" or better (Submit a copy of your high school transcript with the application)

OR

Successful completion of a college level writing course with a grade of "C" or better (Submit a copy of your college transcript with the application)

OR

Successful completion of ESOL 400 or equivalent with a grade of "C" or better (Submit a copy of your college transcript with the application)

OR

Demonstrated placement in a college level ENG 100 or ENG 105, or higher, on the Skyline College English Placement Test (Submit a copy of your placement result with the application)

NOTE: Minimum requirements may be lowered at the discretion of the selection committee, depending on the number of available seats and the number of applicants.
