Resolution No: 2013-001

Resolution urging the Board of Governors to support the Student Success Task Force Professional Development Recommendations

WHEREAS, recent legislation known as the Student Success Act of 2012 includes new professional development goals that have significant impact on classified staff; and

WHEREAS, current professional development opportunities for classified staff are inadequate at best; and

WHEREAS, classified staff training is unequally determined by individual supervisors; and

WHEREAS, classified staff need professional development to serve students to the best of their ability in order to contribute significantly to student success initiatives; and

WHEREAS, professional development opportunities need to be offered on a consistent basis to ensure the system-wide improvement that was the intent of the original legislation; and

WHEREAS, the removal of the mandatory provision by the Chancellor's Office, in effect, removes the assurance that these opportunities will be available for classified staff; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Santa Rosa Junior College Classified Senate urges the Board of Governors to support the Student Success Task Force Professional Development Recommendations which include a minimum of at least (2) mandatory days of professional development for classified staff.
