President

Takes full responsibility for communication with, polling decisions from, and bringing college governance issues to constituents. Several minor speaking engagements are required.

Vice-President

Leads special projects and initiatives as necessary. Provides direct support to the President in every area. May be asked to stand-in in the President's absence or inability to serve.

Treasurer

Responsible for maintaining the self-sustaining budget and reporting details to the Senate. This includes fundraising, activities, professional development and scholarship awards.

Parliamentarian

Responsible for ensuring the formal *Robert's Rules of Order* are followed during meetings. Must become familiar with college bylaws and the senate constitution.

Historian

Responsible for organizing, cataloguing and housing the Senate's historical archive. May be called upon to reference or research historical Senate activity.

Secretary

Responsible for compiling agendas and written documentation, primarily taking and organizing minutes at Senate meetings.
