

How to create a single-question poll using the Choice Activity in WebAccess 2+

What is the "Choice Activity"?

The Choice Activity enables a teacher to **create a single-question poll**, and offer a selection of possible responses.

Choice results may be published after students have answered, after a certain date, or not at all. Results may be published with student names or anonymously.

A choice activity may be used:


- As a quick poll to stimulate thinking about a topic
- To quickly assess students' understanding of a given SLO
- To facilitate student decision-making, for example allowing students to vote on a direction for the course.

How to create a single-question poll using the Choice Activity:

1 – Turn editing on 

2 – Click “Add an activity...” and select **Choice**  ? Choice

3 – Type a name and description for the **Choice Activity**




The **Description** text box is where you enter the question itself. It can be as simple as “Choose your ice cream flavor”

4 – **Display description on course page:** Checking this box will place an additional activity description on your main page, just below the link to your activity.

6 – Choice options:

Here is where you specify the options that participants have to choose from. You can fill in any number of these. If you leave some of the options blank, they will not be displayed. If you need more than 8 options, click the "Add 3 fields to form" button.



5 – Limit the number of responses allowed:

This option allows you to limit the number of participants that can select each choice option. When the limit is reached then nobody else can select that option. If limits are disabled then any number of participants can select each of the options.

7 – **Save, and that's it!** You should now be able to create and use the Choice Activity in Moodle 2+!
