**1) Update Curriculum Processes**

- a) Continue to develop a Curriculum Committee professional development process that broadens the knowledge of local and statewide curriculum issues for Curriculum Committee members.
- b) Continue to revise CurricUNET screens as needed.
- c) Develop a process for assigning courses to disciplines, especially cross-disciplinary or multidisciplinary courses.
- d) Establish a set of criteria for reviewing and approving Honors courses.
- e) Continue to consult with the Distance Education coordinator about developing consistent best practices and language for DE Addendums on course proposals.

**2) Update Major and Degree Requirements**

- a) Continue development, submission and review of Skyline College transfer degrees (including AoE's and MC's) and C-ID course submissions per Transfer Model Curriculum and Intersegmental Model Curriculum guidelines.

**3) Promote Curriculum Integrity**

- a) Promote the Curriculum Committee website to faculty as a tool for curriculum development.

**4) Accreditation**

- a) Annual review and update of Curriculum Handbook.

**5) Comprehensive Program Review**

- a) Assess how the SPOL Comprehensive Program Review instrument is working.
- b) Confirm that a Student Services Comprehensive Program Review instrument has been developed.
- c) Shepherd faculty through the Comprehensive Program Review process with respect to COR modifications and the annual November "how to" workshop.

**6) Bachelor's Degrees**

- a) Continue to monitor and provide curriculum oversight of the Bachelor's degree pilot program in Respiratory Care.

**7) Meta Majors and Guided Pathways**

- a) Support and provide curriculum oversight throughout the comprehensive college redesign.
