

**CURRICULUM COMMITTEE
GOALS AND PROJECTS
2010-2011**

1) Update Curriculum Processes

- a) Continue work with the District steering committee to implement CurricUNET as the curriculum management system for Skyline
- b) Develop a Curriculum Committee professional development process that broadens the knowledge of curriculum issues for Curriculum Committee members

2) Update Major and Degree Requirements

- a) Review and recommend changes to the Associate Degree general education and transfer requirements, including SB1440
- b) Continue to develop the AA/AS General Education Certification process
- c) Adopt an Information Literacy requirement. Through the Information Literacy taskforce, adopt recommendations on how students are to meet the information literacy requirement

3) Promote Curriculum Integrity

- a) Work with the Dean of Planning, Research and Institutional Effectiveness to identify the best and most consistent methodology for completing the highest level of scrutiny in the establishment of prerequisites for courses with prerequisites outside of their discipline
- b) Make recommendations to Academic Senate on elements to be incorporated in course evaluations, including online courses

4) Accreditation

- a) Continue to work with the SLOAC Steering Committee to facilitate completion of an increased number of program and course assessment cycles as recommended by the Accrediting Commission
