GOALS AND PROJECTS
2012-2013**

1) Update Curriculum Processes

- a) Continue work with the District steering committee to implement CurricUNET as the curriculum management system for Skyline.
- b) Develop a Curriculum Committee professional development process that broadens the knowledge of curriculum issues for Curriculum Committee members.
- c) Develop a process for the banking and deletion of courses.

2) Update Major and Degree Requirements

- a) Review and make any necessary changes to Associate Degree general education.
- b) Continue development and submission of Skyline transfer degrees and C-ID course submissions per Transfer Model Curriculum guidelines.

3) Promote Curriculum Integrity

- a) Work with the Dean of Planning, Research and Institutional Effectiveness to identify the best and most consistent methodology for completing the appropriate level of scrutiny in the establishment of out of discipline prerequisites for courses in accordance with Title V.
- b) Review and evaluate the processes and criteria used to approve distance education.
- c) Make changes to course repeatability to be in compliance with state regulations.

4) Accreditation

- a) Continue to work with the SLOAC Steering Committee to facilitate completion of an increased number of program and course assessment cycles through Program Review as required by the Accrediting Commission.
- b) Revise Curriculum Handbook.

5) Comprehensive Program Review

- a) Revision of Comprehensive Program Review for integration into planning.
- b) Revision and review of Annual Program Planning document.
