GOALS AND PROJECTS
2013-2014**

1) Update Curriculum Processes

- a) Continue to develop a Curriculum Committee professional development process that broadens the knowledge of curriculum issues for Curriculum Committee members.
- b) Develop a process for the banking and deletion of courses.
- c) Clarify definitions and review forms in CurricUNET.

2) Update Major and Degree Requirements

- a) Continue development and submission of Skyline College transfer degrees and C-ID course submissions per Transfer Model Curriculum guidelines.

3) Promote Curriculum Integrity

- a) Work with the Dean of Planning, Research and Institutional Effectiveness to identify the best and most consistent methodology for completing the appropriate level of scrutiny in the establishment of out of discipline prerequisites for courses in accordance with Title V.
- b) Make changes to courses as necessary to be in compliance with state repeatability regulations.
- c) Develop an effective assessment tool for the General Education Program.
- d) Develop thematic course pathways for the General Education Program.
- e) Develop a process to assign courses to disciplines.

4) Accreditation

- a) Annual review and update of Curriculum Handbook.
- b) Promote the Curriculum Handbook to faculty as a tool for curriculum development.

5) Comprehensive Program Review

- a) Perform initial assessment of how new Comprehensive Program Review instrument is working.
- b) Develop rubric to give faculty feedback on Comprehensive Program Review to improve the feedback to faculty.
