

Emergency Medical Technology Program Lottery

If more applications are received than seats in the program, a Lottery Protocol is followed to randomly select 30 students for the cohort and 30 students for the waitlist. This number may vary from cohort to cohort.

The waitlisted applicants will be contacted if an admitted student doesn't complete the program requirements or chooses to not enroll in the program.

The Program Lottery is conducted via Zoom, and all eligible applicants will receive a Zoom link to attend. Attendance at the Lottery is optional and will not affect admissions.

Lottery Protocol

Pool A: Applicants who did not get accepted from Pool B in the previous cycle move to Pool A. A Pool A applicant will receive two entries into the lottery, +1 additional entry for each reapplication. To be included in Pool A, you must apply consecutive semesters.

Pool B: New applicants with a completed program application who will be 18 years old by the first day of class and hold a current and valid American Heart Association Basic Life Support Certificate.

Please Note

Any application submitted without the required American Heart Association BLS Certificate by the application deadline will be considered INCOMPLETE and will not be included in the lottery.
