

Emergency Medical Technology Program Lottery

If more applications are received than seats in the program, a Lottery Protocol is followed to randomly select a cohort and waitlist. The waitlisted applicants will be contacted if an admitted student doesn't complete the program requirements or chooses to not enroll in the program. In the Emergency Medical Technology program, 30 applicants will be admitted to each cohort, with up to 15 applicants placed on a waitlist.

Lottery Protocol

Pool A: Applicants who did not get accepted from Pool B the previous semester move to Pool A. A "Pool A" applicant will receive three entries into the lottery, +1 additional entry for each consecutive reapplication. *Please note that you cannot "skip" pool B. You can only go from C to B, or from B to A.*

Pool B: First-time applicants who have submitted an EMT Application. Applicants must be 18 years or older by the first day of class and have an American Heart Association BLS Certificate. Pool B applicants receive 2 entries into the lottery.

Pool C: Previous EMT students that have withdrawn from the program once within the past 1 year and received a W on their transcript. Pool C applicants receive 1 entry into the lottery.

Please Note

Any application submitted without an AHA BLS card will be considered INCOMPLETE and will not be a part of the lottery.

Applications are only kept on file for one semester. If you do not reapply the following semester, you will be considered a first-time applicant in future applications.

Emergency Medical Technology (Certificate) Application Dates:

Apply within April 10 – July 10 for the Fall Semester Course. Fall Semester is from mid-August to mid-December.

Apply within Oct 10 – Dec 10 for the Spring Semester Course. Spring Semester is from mid-January to mid-June.
