



Impact of Budget Situation

- Creativity and Strategy – at the same time
- Collaboration with colleges across the district
- Prioritization of all aspects of the institution
- May lead to reductions in programs



Process

- Governance Processes
 - Academic Senate
 - Instructional Leadership Team
 - Curriculum Committee
- Collaborate across the District



Examples of Creative Approaches

- 
- New
 - Combine lecture sections (3unit course – hold for 2 hours per week)
 - 1 hour discussion group (smaller size)
 - Example:
 - 221 students in lect (2 flc)
 - 5 discussion groups (5 flc)
- Former
 - 4 sections (12 flc)
 - Difference 5flc
 - Consider lcs pay
 - (ideas from SSCA division meeting)

Timeline

- September/October
 - CC Committee collects recommendations for programs undergoing PIV and names of committee members.
 - Identify evaluation committee
 - Hold an Open Meetings
- October/November
 - Program faculty and staff notified
 - Consideration of programs by subcommittee
 - Preliminary discussion with program faculty and staff
 - Preliminary results/data of identified programs considered by subcommittee
 - Committee.
- Subcommittee presents final program deliberation results and recommendation to Curriculum
- December
 - Curriculum Committee forwards evaluation results and recommendations to the President, Office of Instruction and the Academic Senate.
