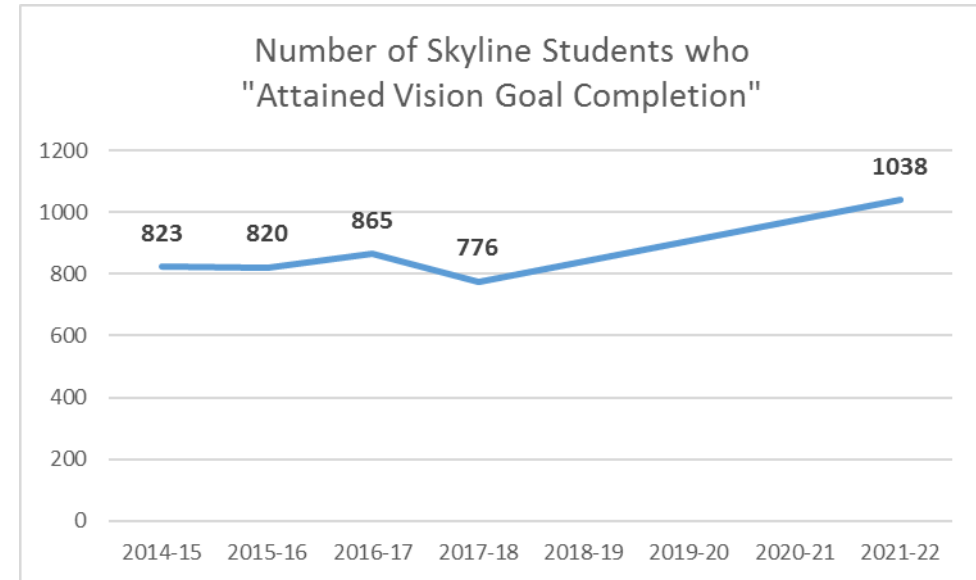
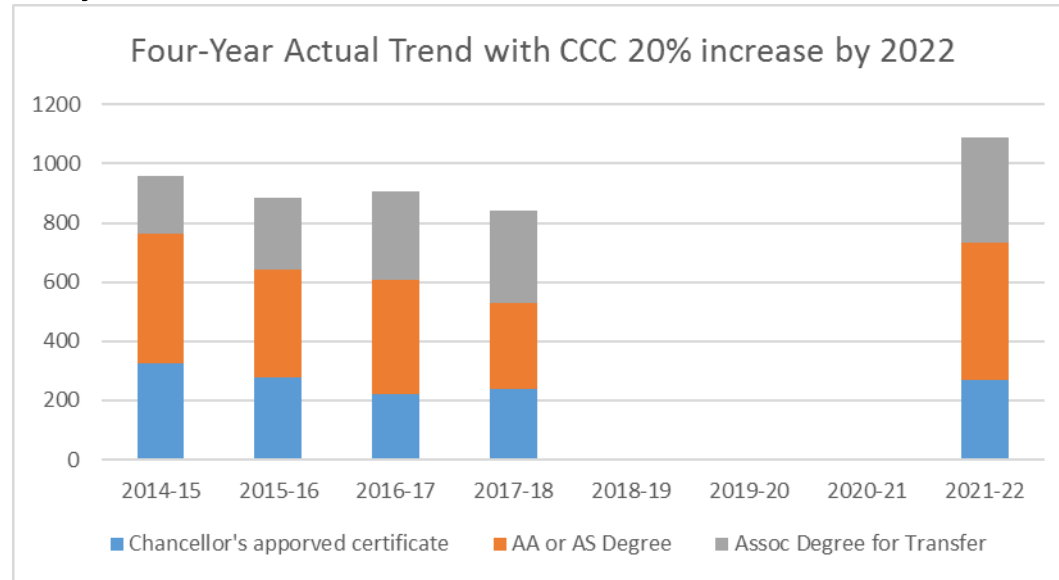

# Goal 1: Completion

## Systemwide Goal

Increase by at least 20% [over 5 years] the number of CCC students annually who acquire associate degrees, credentials, certificates, or specific job-oriented skill sets.

## Skyline Goal

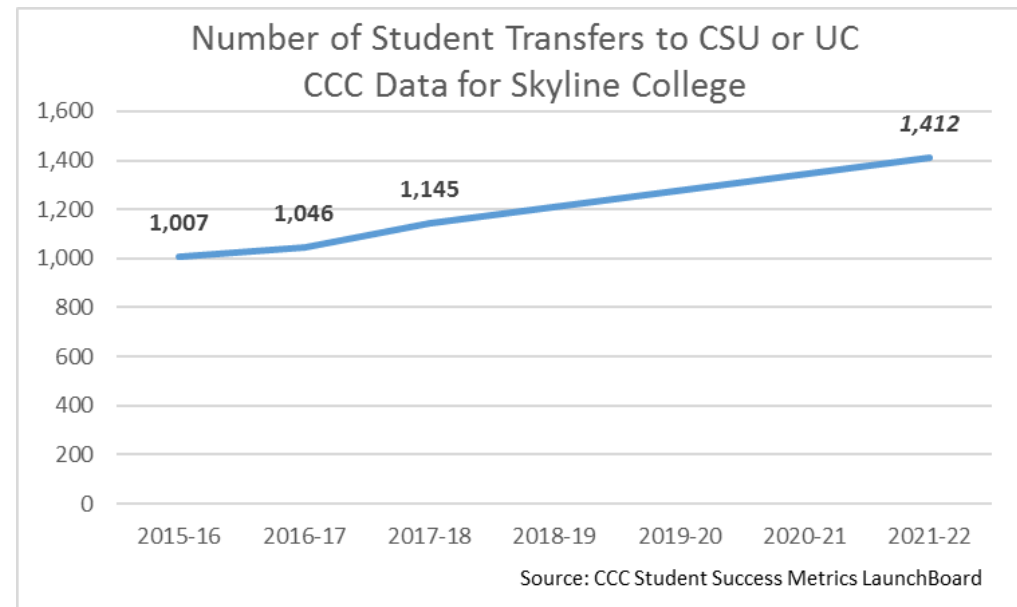
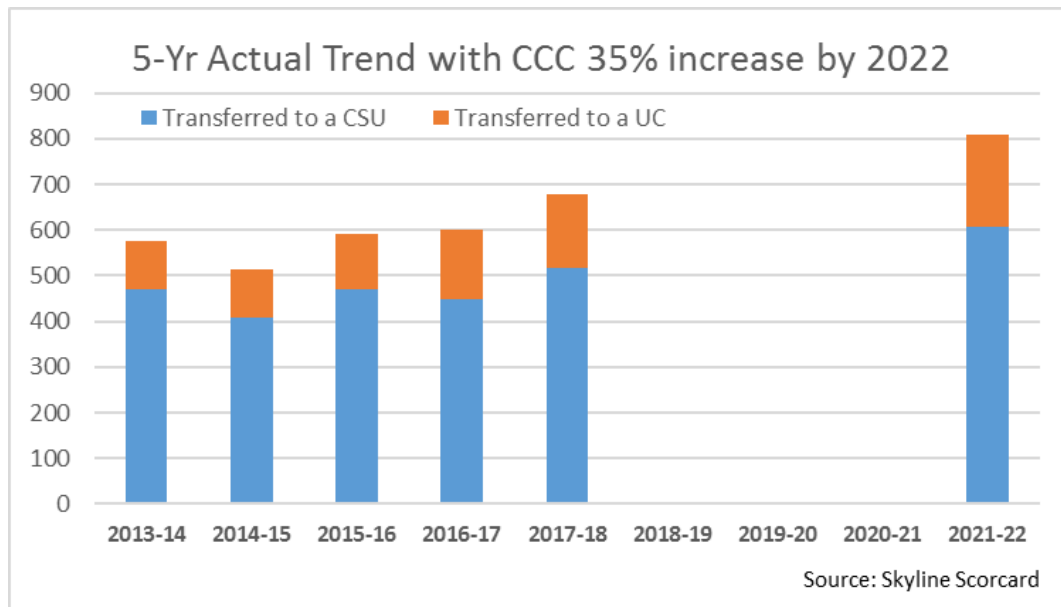
Skyline College will increase among all students, the unduplicated count of students who earned one or more of the following: Chancellor's Office approved certificate, associate degree, and/or CCC baccalaureate degree, and had an enrollment in the selected or previous year **from 865 students in 2016-17 to 1,038 students in 2021-22.**

## Goal 2: Transfers

### Systemwide Goal

Increase by at least 35% [over 5 years] the number of CCC students system-wide transferring annually to a UC or CSU

### Skyline Goal

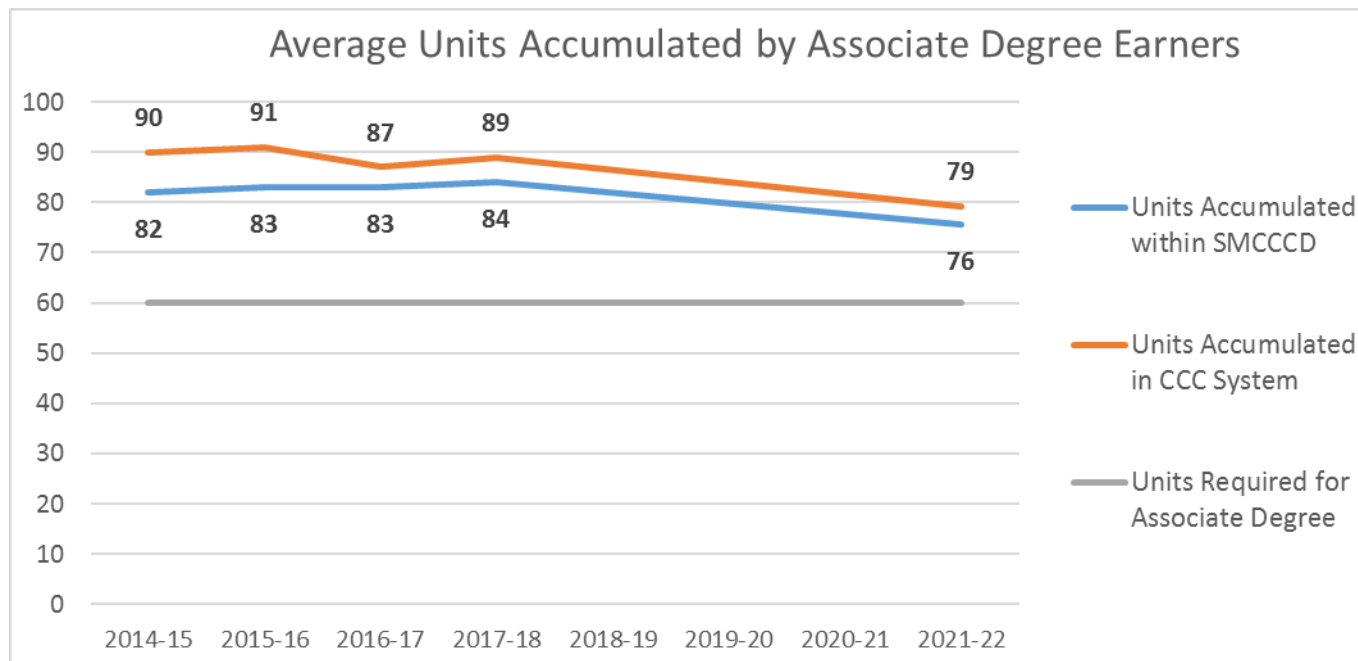
Skyline College will increase among all students, the number who transferred to a CSU or UC institution from **1,046 students in 2016-17 to 1,412 students in 2021-22.**

## Goal 3: Unit Accumulation

### Systemwide Goal

Decrease the average number of units accumulated by CCC students earning associate degrees, from approximately 87 total units to 79 total units, a decrease of 9% [over 5 years].

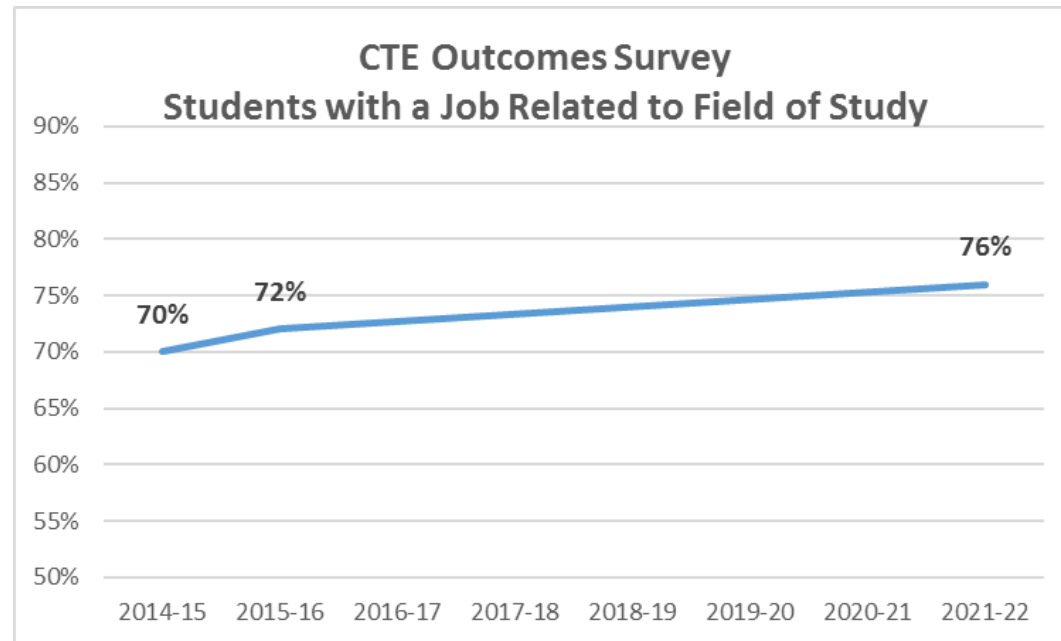
### Skyline Goal

Skyline College will decrease, among all students who earned an associate degree, the average number of units earned in the CCC system **from 87 in 2016-17 to 79 in 2021-22.**

## Goal 4: Workforce Systemwide Goal

Increase the percent of exiting students who report being employed in their field of study, from the most recent statewide average of 69% to 76%, an increase of 9% [over 5 years].

### Skyline Goal

Skyline College will increase among all students who responded to the CTE Outcomes Survey and did not transfer, the proportion who reported that they are working in a job 'very closely' or 'closely' related to their field of study **from 70% in 2016-17 to 76% in 2021-22.**

## Goal 5: Equity

### Systemwide Goal

Reduce equity gaps across all of the above measures through faster improvements among traditionally underrepresented student groups, with the goal of cutting achievement gaps by 40% within 5 years and fully closing those achievement gaps for good within 10 years.

### Skyline Goal

Skyline College will reduce the equity gaps for disproportionately impacted groups in each of the aforementioned vision metrics with the goal of **cutting achievement gaps by 40% within 5 years.**
