

### Dr. Grant Larson



Equally comfortable in both classical and jazz settings, saxophonist **Grant Larson** regularly performs with the Colorado Symphony Orchestra, the Cheyenne Symphony Orchestra, and the Colorado Music Festival Orchestra. As a jazz artist, he has released two albums under his own name, and most recently, a collaborative album (*Ascent*) of original jazz compositions with fellow musicians Greg Tanner Harris, Matt Fuller, Braun Khan, and Dave Hammond. Grant holds a Doctor of Musical Arts degree in Saxophone Performance and Pedagogy from the University of Colorado at Boulder; a Master of Music from the University of Colorado; and a Bachelor of Music from Concordia College. He currently serves on the faculty at Red Rocks Community College, as the Saxophone Practicing Artist at Denver School of the Arts, is the wind ensemble conductor for the Colorado Youth Symphony Orchestras, and as the Jazz Camp program director at Rocky Ridge Music.
