Welcome and Introductions

President's Update

- Dr. Regina Stanback Stroud shared the news of the loss of Carolyn Livengood, a member of the President's Council. She asked for a moment of silence in her honor.
- Skyline College Promise/College Redesign information was shared.
 - Redesign of our degrees and certificates.
 - Reworking the Curriculum.
 - Provide an opportunity for students to get in get through and graduate.
- Accreditation process has begun. The visit will be in October 2019.
- Environmental Science Building plans to be open December 2019.
 - Outdoor Classrooms.
 - Preserving the trails and will be available to the public.
 - Many resources to the community.
 - The building will provide a 250 person event space.
- Faculty and Staff housing update.
 - Housing available at CSM and Canada Colleges.
 - 30 units will be built on the Skyline College campus. There will be 1, 2, and 3 bedroom townhouses available.
 - Occupancy of the housing will be Spring 2020.
 - Outdoor fitness parks are going to be created for the public and the new community.
 - The Faculty and Staff Housing is offered at below market rate.
 - There are currently 200 employees on the waitlist for housing.
- Lot L
 - New parking lot.
 - Additional EV charger stations available on campus.
 - The lot will open December 1, 2017.

Transportation

- Skyline College applied for funding from the transportation authority in San Mateo County. If funded we can continue to provide direct shuttle service from Daly City BART station to Skyline College.
- July 1, 2016 is when the Shuttle began operating service from the Daly City BART station to Skyline College.

- Skyline College Shuttle ridership 8,800 per month.
- The Shuttle provides multiple trips to and from Skyline College and the Daly City BART station daily, Monday – Friday.
- The Shuttle was an outcome from the first Success Summit.

Marketing and Outreach Overview

- The Community Relations and Marketing Office and the Outreach Office work very closely together.
- Outreach Office is housed under the Enrollment Services Department.
- Lauren Ford is the College Recruiter for Skyline College and she works closely with our High School partners.

Success Summit Recap

- The format was changed this year from three breakout sessions to two breakout sessions.
- The attendees were happy with the new format of the event.
- The Summit received double the amount of sponsorships as the previous year.
- The group reviewed the evaluations from the Success Summit.
- Overall rating of the event were 4's and 5's out of 5.
