



**President's Council
Shared Responsibilities and Personal Pledge
2019-2020**

On behalf of Skyline College, President's Council members are ambassadors of good will and connection to the community. The primary role of the President's Council is to provide community input and feedback for the resource development program at Skyline College.

Membership of the Council includes representatives from business, industry, government, nonprofits and other organizations whose commitment to Skyline College provides a strong base of knowledge and support for the President, the College and the communities it serves.

In order to fulfill the above, President's Council members place Skyline College high on their list of priorities, lend their expertise and knowledge to Skyline College, and devote sufficient time and energy to assist in the ongoing development of the President's Council.

Council Member Principal Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Provide counsel to the President at meetings and as needed when contacted in writing, e-mail or by telephone.
- Serve as ambassadors in the community, both informally by remaining knowledgeable and enthusiastic about the College's programs, and formally when requested by the College to represent the College at official functions.
- Provide names of potential community funding or partnership sources on a regular basis.
- Support the College financially either personally and / or through their corporate or institutional affiliation, at an appropriate level.
- Attend all meeting of the President's Council and any committees joined.
- Exercise both expertise and connection on behalf of Skyline College.
- If desired, request opportunities to discuss the Council's programs, goals, activities, and status with the Skyline College President and the Council Chair.

Skyline College Principal Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Provide timely information about meetings, events and issues in the field of higher education and philanthropy to President Council members to support successful participation.

- Promptly respond to questions that are necessary to carry out Council members' responsibilities to the organization. Council members and College personnel will work in good faith toward achievement of our goals
- Offer Council members opportunities to discuss the Council's programs, goals, activities, and status with the Skyline College President and the Council Chair.

President's Council Member Key Engagement Activities:

Participation in Council Meetings

Attend and actively participate in Council meetings. The Council meets only four times a year (2019-2020 Schedule: September 12, December 5, January 23, April 9)

Committee Participation

Serve on committees and / or take on a special assignment as needed. Current committees include: President's Breakfast and Success Summit

President's Council Events (Summit, Gala, Donor Appreciation, Breakfast)

Attend and support Council events including the Success Summit, 50th Anniversary Gala, Donor Appreciation Event and President's Breakfast.

Philanthropy

Make a contribution at a level that is personally significant and meaningful. Participate actively in engaging members of the community by acting as an ambassador, advocate and asker for Skyline College and the President's Council Fund that supports President's Innovation Projects and the Skyline Promise Scholars Program.

Council Development

Bring forward viable candidates to the President and Council.

Notification and Response

Stay in touch and notify the Council of changes in your ability to perform as a Council member. Respond in a timely and professional manner to members of the Council and staff.
