Faculty Door Cards

We are off to an outstanding start in supporting our students by providing them easy access to faculty office hours. As of this morning, we have 97% of the full-time faculty door cards available to students on our website. Update on the Facilities Master Plan and the next wave of construction

I described in my Opening Day remarks the need for us to scale back our construction plans for the Design/Build portion of the next wave of construction. I reviewed the buildings and Sitework which are part of that project and briefly described five scenarios for achieving the budget reduction for the project. Each would have its own negative and positive effects. I noted that I have invited our Educational and Facilities Master Plan Project Task Force (EFMPP) to a meeting on August 30 to advise me on our best approach to the gap between our original plans and our budget. I promised to make available some documents to help people think about all this, and those are now on our website at http://www.skylinecollege.edu/skynotes/. They include a more detailed written description of the background of the issue and the five scenarios, a side-by-side comparison of the negative and positive effects of the scenarios, and a detailed description of all the buildings and the Sitework which were slated to be part of this project.
