The PSLOs have not been assessed formally. However, the Dual Enrollment team has been mindful of tracking student success independently as captured via the Skyline College Tableau. Additionally team growth has been a priority for the District over the past 3 years to increase program capacity.

ii. What have you learned from reviewing the PSLO results? What may account for these results? What are their implications for your programming?

Overall, students have been able to successfully complete the Dual Enrollment courses. However, there was a dip in course success (and delay in reporting) in 22-23AY in part due to significant transition in the Dual Enrollment team where we lacked effective retention support to ensure student success.

Recent staffing transitions over the 22-23AY significantly impacted the capacity of the Dual Enrollment program to sustain program growth and provide dedicated support to ensure student success. While the

current team has managed to maintain basic programmatic operations, they are doing so at 50% capacity. With increased staffing support the team will be better suited to manage the day-to-day operations of the program, adhere to reporting regular requirements, and ideate opportunities for growth and expansion.

Dual Enrollment Student & Family Resource Guides have been created and distributed. Dual Enrollment pathway maps have also been developed and shared with Dual Enrollment students and instructors.

Sharing the Program Pathway Maps, especially, has opened the door for more discussions around Dual Enrollment pathway opportunities. Both in the configuration and sequence of courses offered, the future connections to Skyline College programs and matriculation into the courses, and the opportunities for students to earn a Skyline College credential along the way. Future discussion with counseling will be essential to ensuring that maps accurately reflect anticipated student experiences. They will also assist with discussions with high school partner districts around how to best offer dual enrollment courses within their school in support of the student experience.
