

In the following emergencies, immediate care is crucial. Call 9-911. Notify the Health Center x4270 and Security x4199. Have someone else call if possible.

- **Severe burns**
- **Uncontrolled bleeding**
- **Suspected fracture of neck or back**
- **Suspected poisoning**
- **Severe chest pain ...suspected heart attack**
- **Respiratory distress or cessation of breathing**
- **Prolonged unconsciousness**

If the person is not breathing:

1. **Flip to section on HEART ATTACK / STOPPAGE OF BREATHING. Start rescue breathing immediately.**
2. **The first 4 minutes are critical! Have someone call 9-911. State why you are calling and your location. Do not hang up until the emergency dispatcher hangs up.**
3. **Ask someone to notify the Health Center and Campus Security.**
