2010-2011 Committee Goals

1. Develop a holistic diversity framework and create an action agenda. Identify a research agenda that is relevant to the diversity framework.
2. Develop and implement professional development/flex day opportunities that can be shared district-wide. Perform an analysis of what programs and services are effective in supporting student success and closing the achievement gap.
3. Increase dialogue regarding effective classroom practices. Share practices using a deliberate Scholarship on Teaching and Learning approach that facilitates faculty to faculty dialogues. Draw from On Course training to address this goal.

1. Approval of the Minutes – 9/28/10 minutes approved as written (Tyler/Johnstone)

 Committee reminded to use SharePoint sight. The committee was asked to post items as desired. The chair encouraged the sharing of diversity related resources. SharePoint also has a discussion board. Group encouraged to use it to engage in smaller group discussion.
3. Status on Student Representative: Mark Feldman has been appointed and is in attendance. Welcome Mark.



4. Strategy for reaching goals
 - a. Diversity Framework (process and timeline) – recommendation provided by Regina and Rob. Process and timeline attached.

We are working on A-Diversity Framework (process and timeline). In the minutes of the last meeting, we talked about the framework support and what needs to go into it. We decided that Regina and Rob would make a recommendation about process and timeline. They discussed it and developed one, which was distributed. The first page is process and on the back is the timeline. Regina took the group's suggestions from the September meeting and used the diversity framework from the University of Minnesota, which the committee reviewed. Items I, II and III make up the diversity framework. Under III, priority domains were identified, which include, hiring, admissions, registration policies, scholarship et al.

A mini equity review using some of the formal review processes will be completed. At the conclusion of the process, domain specific priorities and recommendations should emerge. Rob: we will keep these in mind and then move toward creating the domains, and then develop the benchmarks and way to audit. For December Rob and Regina can work on identifying the resources needed. In February, we will discuss definitions and context setting. It means we need to have people interested in doing this lead the conversations, so that as we do the equity audits, we know what context we are working in, grounded in our mission, vision, goals and define what we mean when we talk about diversity. Then, we can then complete the equity audits in the various domains.

At each of the meetings, we would have someone lead the discussion on the particular audits. In spring we look at it and in summer pull together the document (see timeline for language). In September, we come back to a draft diversity framework that we can start getting feedback on. The various drafts will be looked at by the constituencies and the third draft is completed in December 2011, which would be approved by college council in February 2012.

Regina talked about the history of the SEEED/Student Equity Committee. SEEED formed a few years ago. The Student Success Committee disbanded for awhile, but was reformed in 2008 and renamed Student Equity Committee.

The recommended framework includes potential domains listed under III. The University of Minnesota's holistic diversity framework suggested that people look at different areas (domains) within categories, such as Leadership (academic senate,



students, classified, president, etc.). Regina said a domain in student support services may be assessment. The domains listed filtered out of the SEED/Student Equity Committee's discussions in September. The committee discussed possible domains. Nina recommended adding community connections (resources that might come from the community, partnerships, mentorships, etc.) be included. Scholarship may be too broad, but it does need to include classroom activities. Regina does not recall a discussion in Curriculum Committee about equity. The committee identified the following domains:

Committee approval of the Recommended Diversity Framework Process and Timeline

The SEEED/Student Equity Committee approved the adoption of the framework process and timeline.

Follow-Up

- Rob will draft a statement of work and create a definition of equity audit and an explanation of how it is done in an informational sheet for the group.
- Regina and Rob will communicate with the groups to get their approval on their assignments.
- Rob will lead the February meeting with Regina to talk about the definitions and context setting.
- The actual dates of the audits will be communicated at the February 22 meeting, but the tentative dates are:
 - March 22 (Domains 3, 1); April 26 (Domains 2,6) and May (date to be determined) (Domains 4, 5/7/8)
- Strategies for reaching the other two goals relating to classroom activity dialogue and professional development will be talked about at a future meeting.
- Regina will talk to Jasmine Witham about setting up a guest email account for Mason Feldman so he can access the SharePoint site.

Components	Approach	Note
I. Definitions	<p>Define Diversity and connect it to discovery, academic and scholarly excellence</p> <p>Establish an aim of transformation instead of celebration</p>	
II. Context Setting	<p>Connect to Vision, Mission, Goals and Strategies – analyze for integration and gaps</p> <p>Inventory of work already underway</p>	
III. Priority Domains	<p>Establish priority domains (hiring, admissions processes, registration policies, Scholarship such as curricular and pedagogical approaches, institutional climate, leadership, and student support) and perform a “mini equity audit”</p> <p>Select the key measurements, intermediate milestones, cohort tracking in basic skills, and identify 4-7key benchmarks. Use an agenda item to identify the measurements; examples that are not about student outcomes but more campus related. Consider using Noel Levitz for examples. This will incorporate gender, age, and other variables This approach may lead to recommendations in the priority domains in areas such as curriculum, international education, online education, student service processes.</p>
