Questions Asked:

Q1: Do you feel like every diverse student population on campus is being supported? If not, which ones?

Q2: How would you define equity as a student on campus?(i.e. being treated fairly by all, having learning communities, having diverse leadership etc.)

Q3: How do you think we can better advertise our various campus programs and resources to incoming students at Skyline?

Q4: Have you ever used the learning center and it's resources? If so, how did you initially hear about it?

I received 16 student responses.

First and Second Question Responses

Do you feel like every diverse student population on campus is being supported? If not, which ones?

56% of students agreed that the student population is well supported.

Groups with a “lack of representation”

- First generation Students, International students, students with disabilities, Native American population, foster youth, etc.

How would you define equity as a student on campus?(i.e. being treated fairly by all, having learning communities, having diverse leadership etc.)

“Equity is having a program/group where a student of any background feels welcome. Each group should have strong leadership and actively do outreach do those under-served students, make them feel welcome, and help them reach their educational/professional goals with their unique challenges in mind.”

Third and Fourth Questions Responses

How do you think we can better advertise our various campus programs and resources to incoming students at Skyline?

Some suggestions:

Introductory emails to students in their first semester for different learning communities,

classroom presentation

Being mandatory during orientation, separate orientation that focuses on campus programs and resources to new students, making a video presentation for online students

Going to high schools and presenting about Skyline and resources

Have you ever used the learning center and it's resources? If so, how did you initially hear about it?

75% of students surveyed know about the learning center

Heard through:

- **Classroom presentations, Counselors, word of mouth.**

Most however, have not used its services yet.
