




#### **EFFECTIVE ASSESSMENT PRACTITIONERS:**

- ☐ make outcomes visible to students;
- ☐ incorporate outcomes into faculty practice;
- assess an assignment that aligns with the SLOs;
- collaborate with colleagues to establish criteria;
- use outcomes, assessments and results for ongoing conversations about teaching effectiveness and practices;
- ☐ forge action plans, when needed;
- assess anew to determine if the changes have an impact.

### **ASSESSMENT STEPS**

- ☐ Articulate course outcomes.
- ☐ Develop a meaningful and sustainable assessment plan.
- □ Collect assessment results.
- ☐ Make meaning from the assessment results.
- ☐ Use assessment results to inform and implement action plans and/or leverage institutional resources to address gaps in learning.
- ☐ Begin the cycle anew...

#### POTENTIAL ACTIVITIES

- Analyze results from prior semester(s) and shape action plans.
- Establish the parameters for assessment (e.g., identify common characteristics of assignments being assessed, create a common task/ activity/test question(s), determine when the assessment will take place and under which conditions-- such as sample size from all of the sections of a course...).
- Create needed instruments such as rubrics.
- Host "norming" sessions to ensure consistency in applying rubrics.
- Analyze alignment of course level SLOs to PSLOs.
- Determine what will be assessed this year and whom to contact.
