Score	Qualitative Assessment
1	Represents potential value with respect to student impact, generally aligned with Board and College goals, however analysis may be preliminary or incomplete.
2	Represents potential value with respect to student impact, specific components align with Board and College goals, may pose a degree of overlap or duplication with an existing effort or initiative.
3	Good potential value with respect to student impact, good alignment with Board and College goals & MVV, recommend prioritize for a future period.
4	Timely, good potential value with respect to student impact, strong alignment with Board and College goals, MVV.
5	Timely, high potential value with respect to student outcomes, excellent alignment with Board and College goals, MVV.
