## Implementation of <u>CPR Task Force Recommendations</u>

- Institutional Effectiveness Committee (IEC) supports programs undergoing review by hosting an orientation and consultations
- Piloted Comprehensive Program Review (CPR) and Program Review Update (PRU) Templates
  - $\odot$  Piloted the CPR Checklist
- Extended CPRs to every seven years over three semesters and replaced Annual Program Plans (APPs) with Program Review Updates (PRUs) twice between CPR cycles
- Gathered signatures of reporting dean, VP, and when applicable, Curriculum Committee Chair

## CURRICULAR SUPPORT: LOCUS OF CONTROL

- Program Data Packets include Course Enrollment and Success Rates
- Close collaboration between the IEC, the Curriculum Committee and the CTTL's Instructional Designers
- Spring Curriculum Committee CPR Orientation to initiate inquiry
- Optional Summer Curriculum Institute
  - "Kick-off" and "Wrap up" workshops
  - Up to 40 hours special-rate stipends for faculty teams to review and update course outlines of record and review course sequencing recommendations

IEC reviewing best means for programs to share CPR highlights

## CPR TEMPLATE CHANGES IN RESPONSE TO FEEDBACK

Consolidated goals under one section

Streamlined alignment of program to the MVV with dropdown menu and combined commentary

Removed ISLOs from CPR so it's only addressed in the PRUs

□ Added SLO questions about how much has been assessed

Integrated resource request process into program review



## **IMPROVEMENT PLATFORM**

- ✓ One-stop shop for program review and SLO assessment
- ✓ More efficient navigation
- ✓ Related programs share the same template
- ✓ Multiple people can work on it at once
- ✓ Access to Student Learning Outcome (SLO) dashboards and program data as you complete your CPR/ PRU
- ✓ Ability to add, track and update progress on program goals
- ✓ Ability to submit resource requests that align with program goals

#### Resource Requests: Closing the Loop

- Consultations with deans on resource requests
- Implementation of CPR Task Force recommendation: February feedback at division meetings on resource request prioritization
- Resource Request dashboards
- Funding updates to programs
