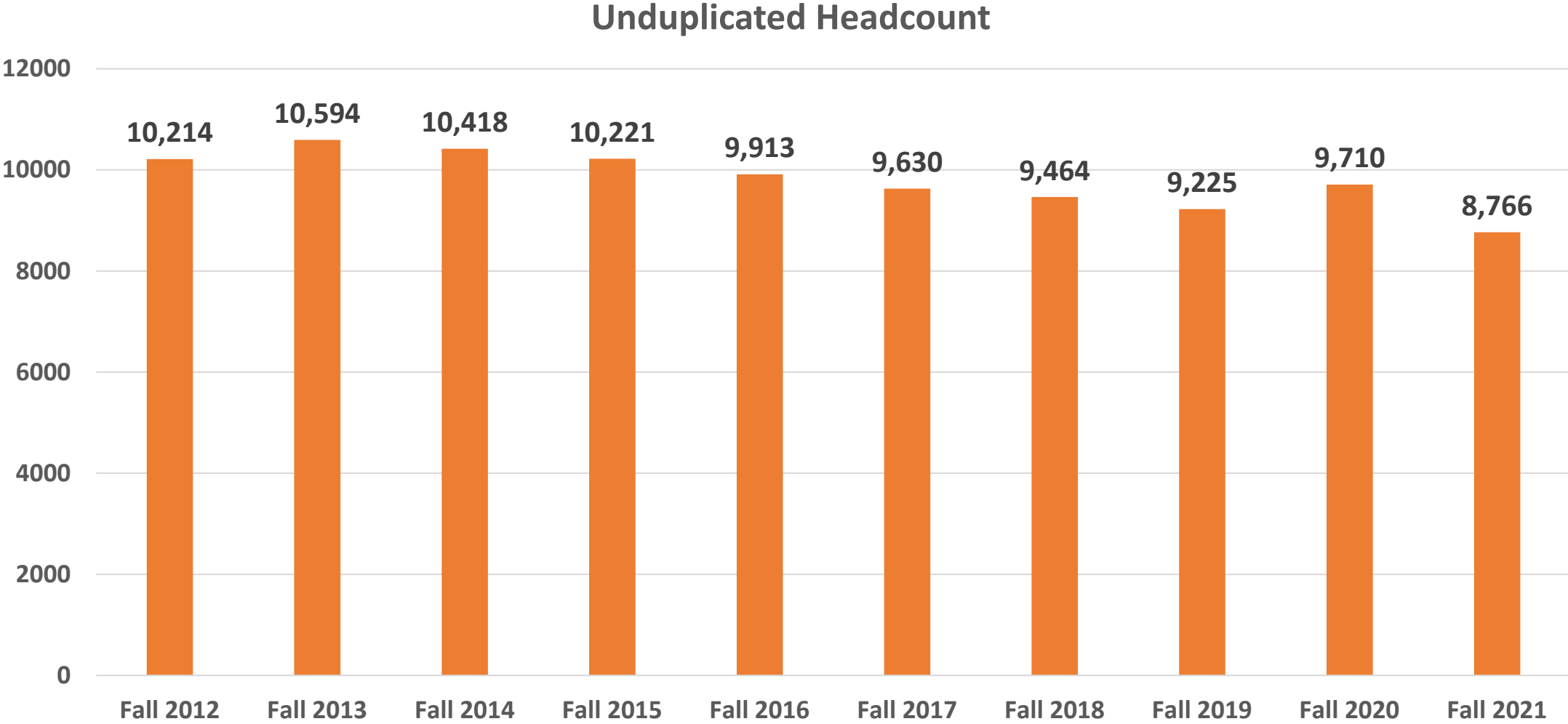




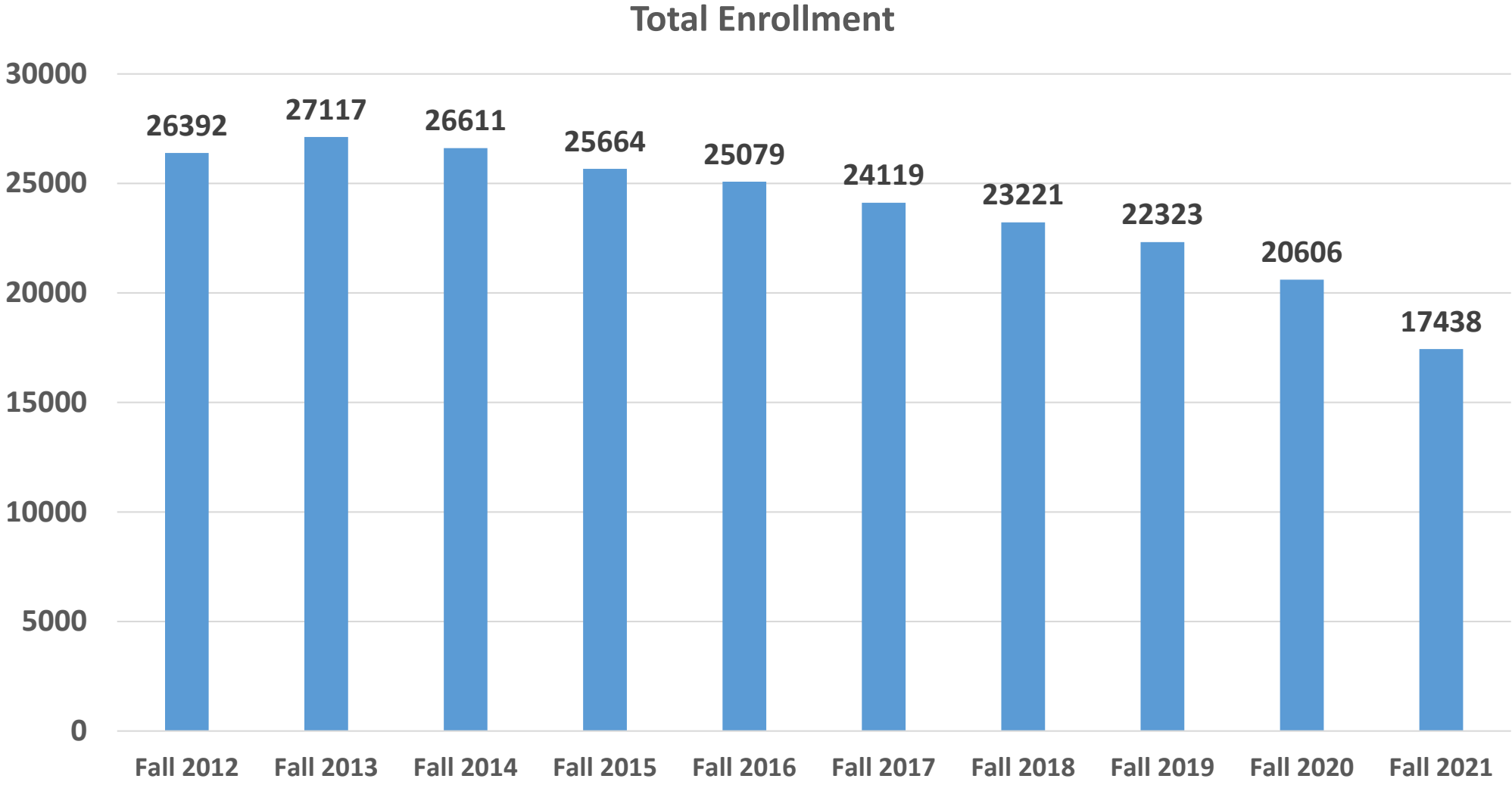

# Fall Student Headcount, 10 Year Trend

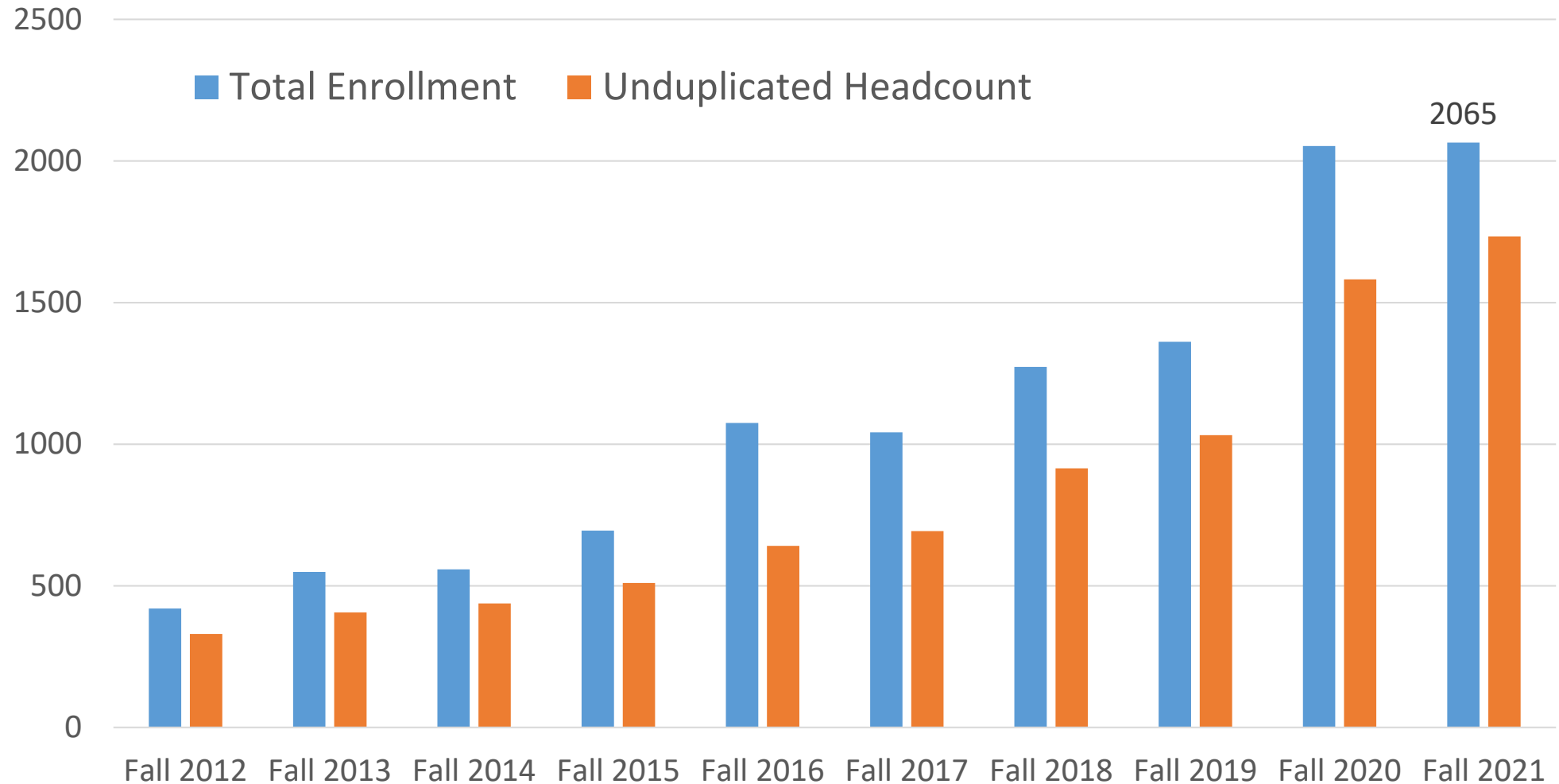


# Fall Student Enrollment, 10 Year Trend

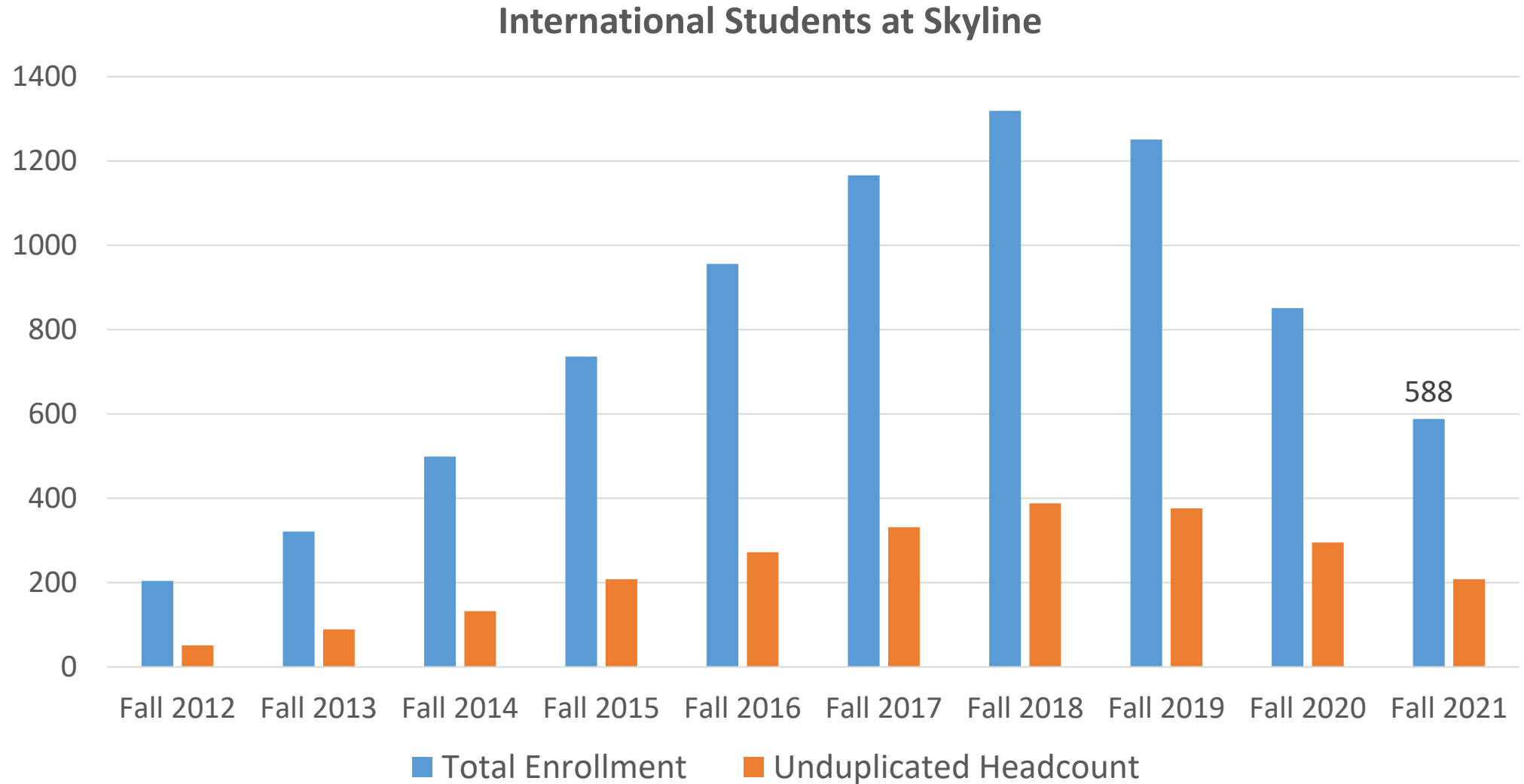


# High School Student Enrollment and Headcount

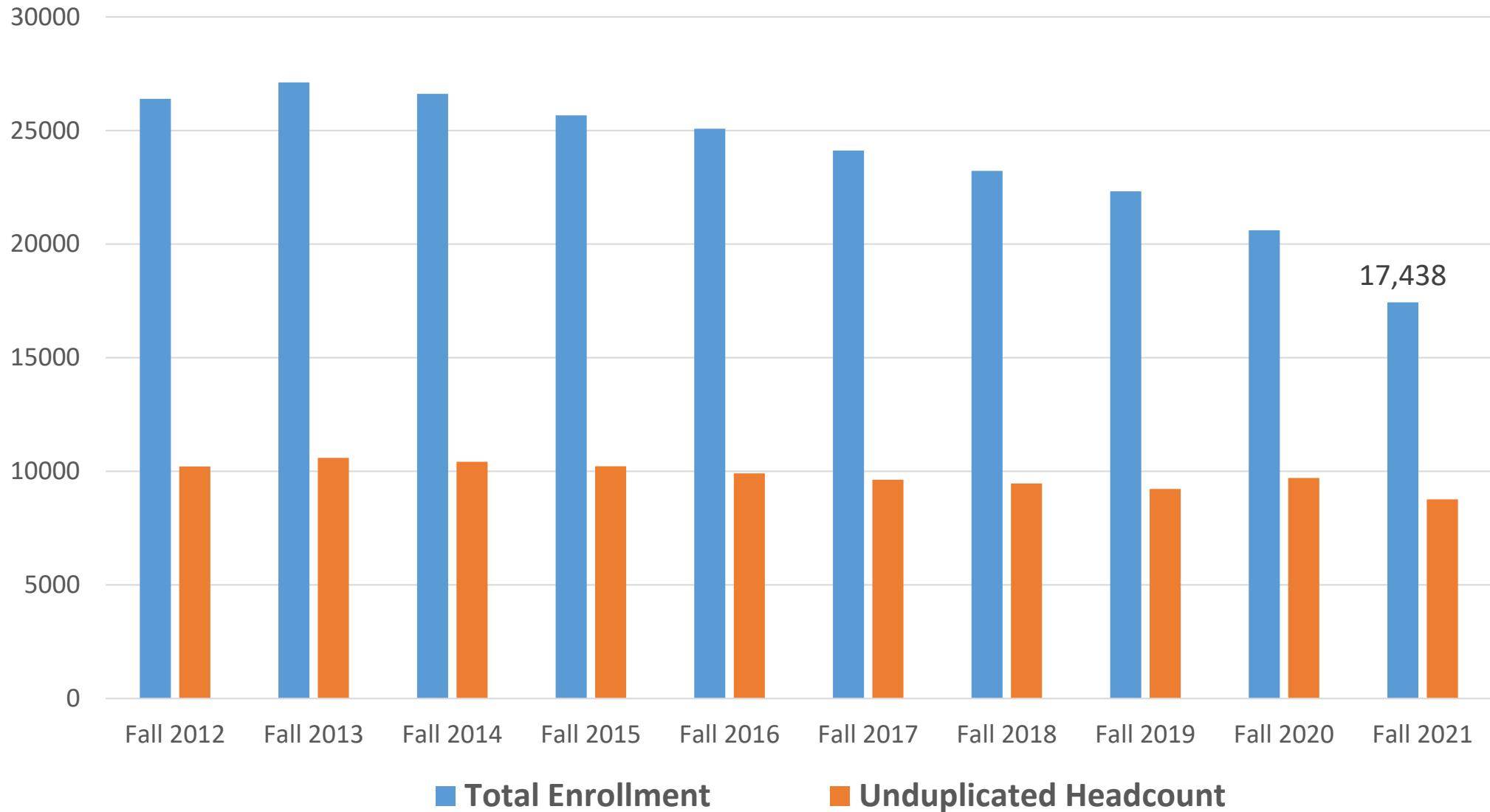

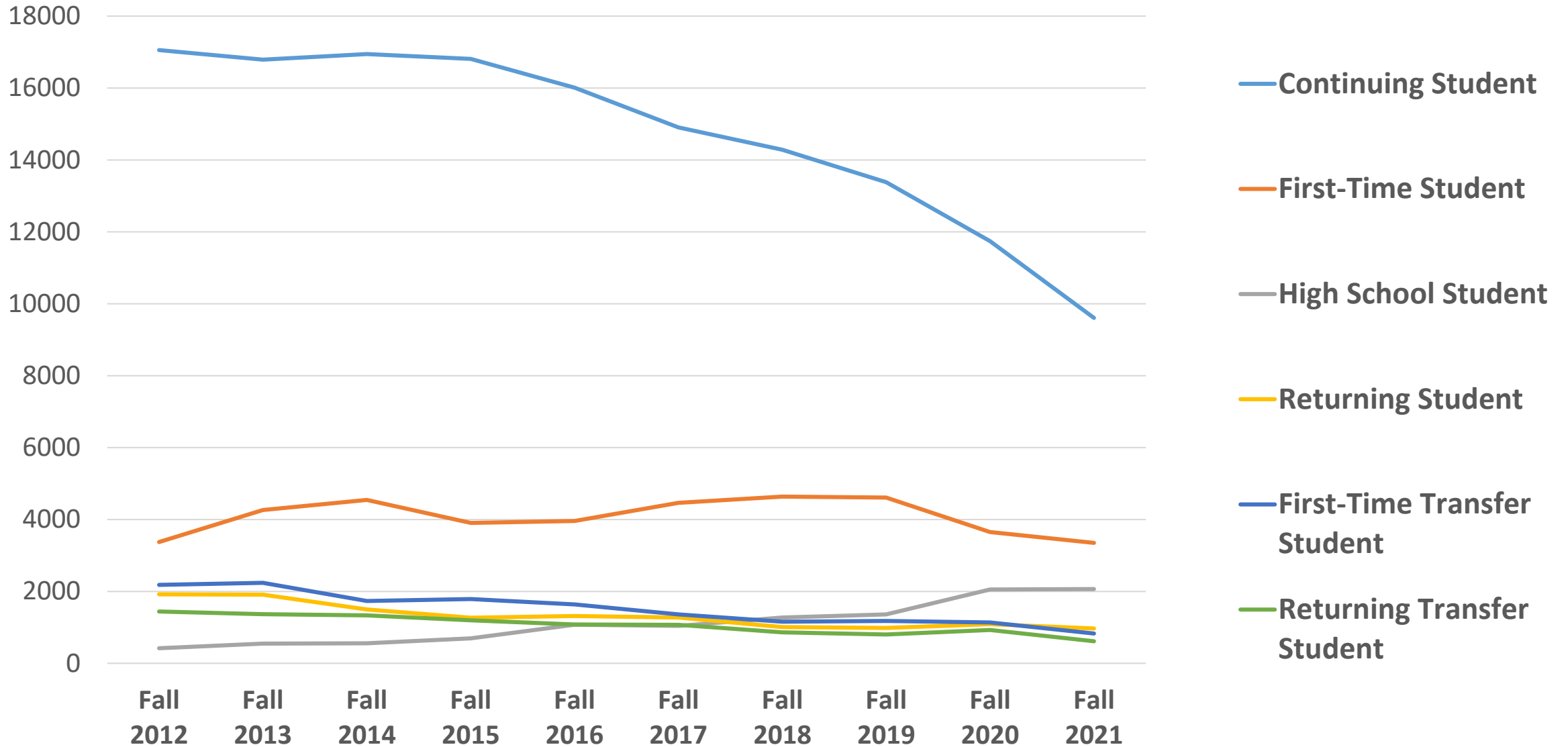

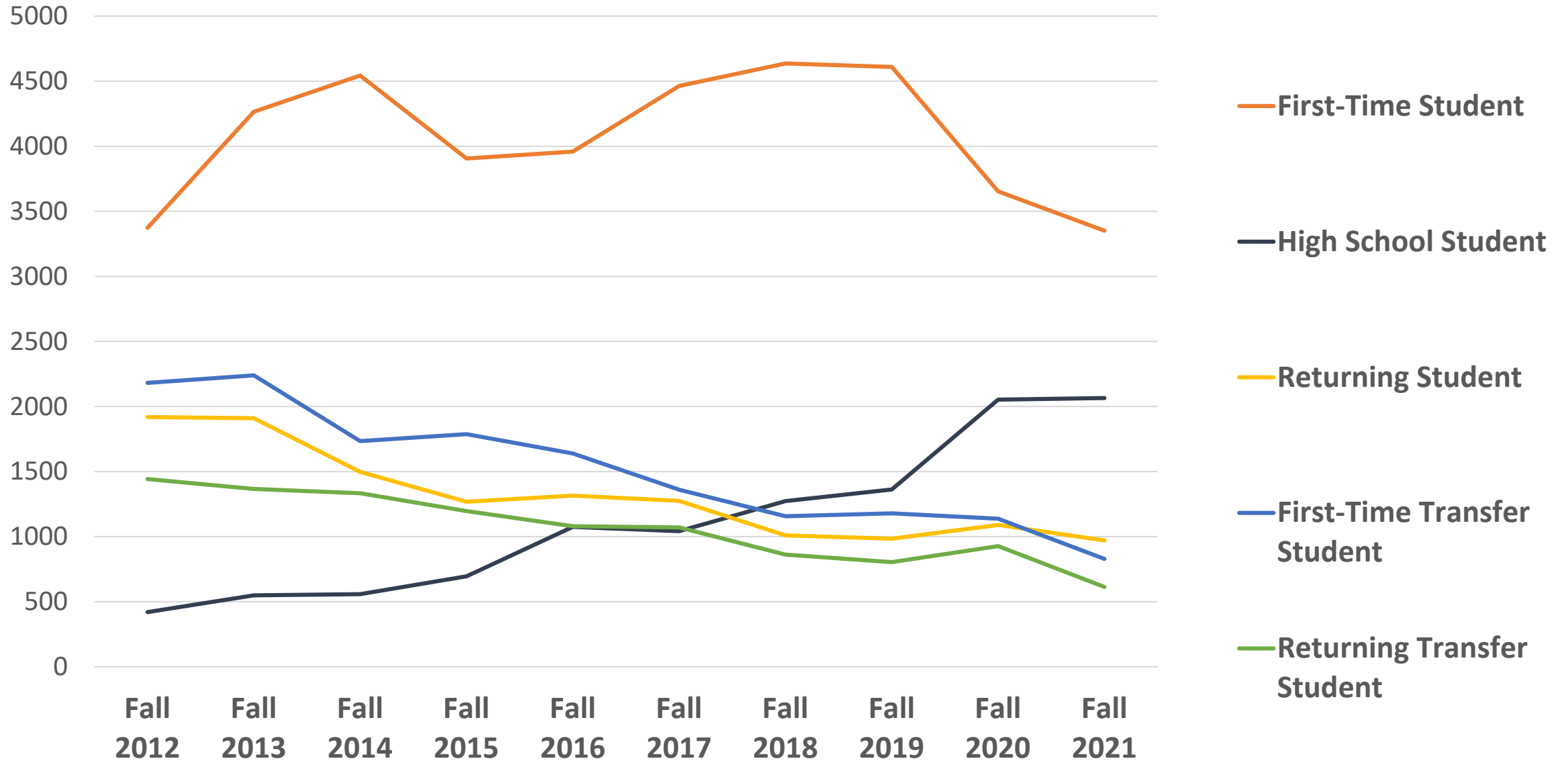
# Fall Enrollments by Student Type



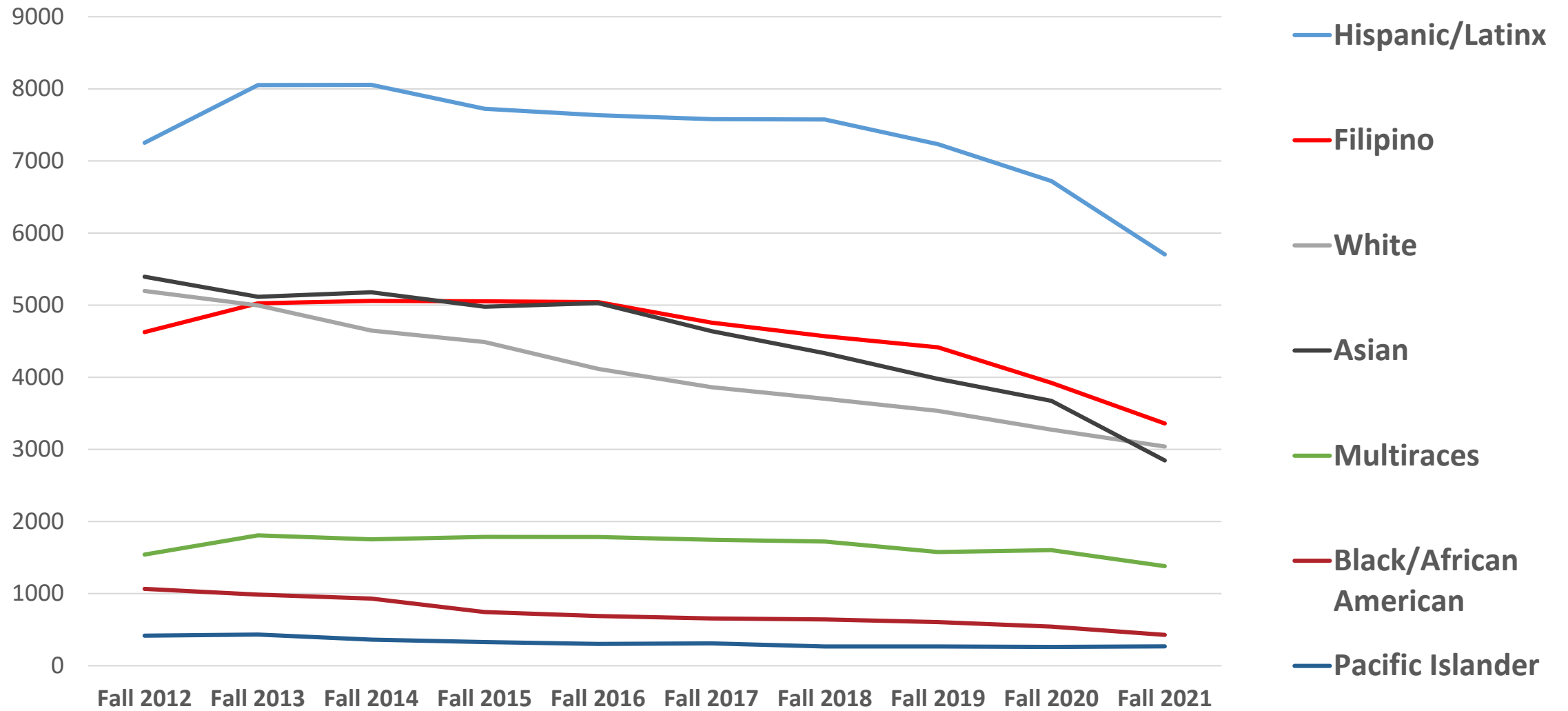

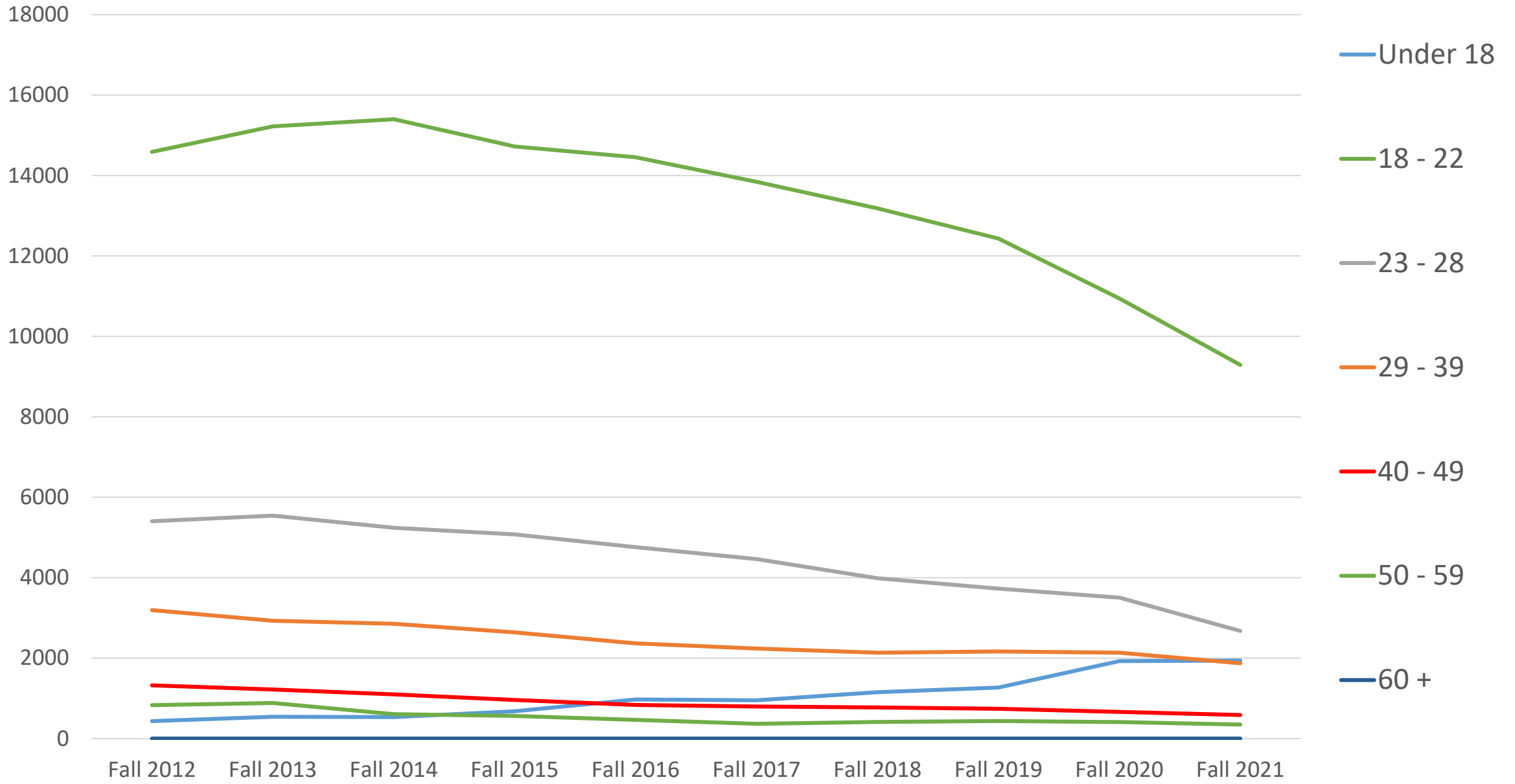

# Fall Enrollments by Race/Ethnicity

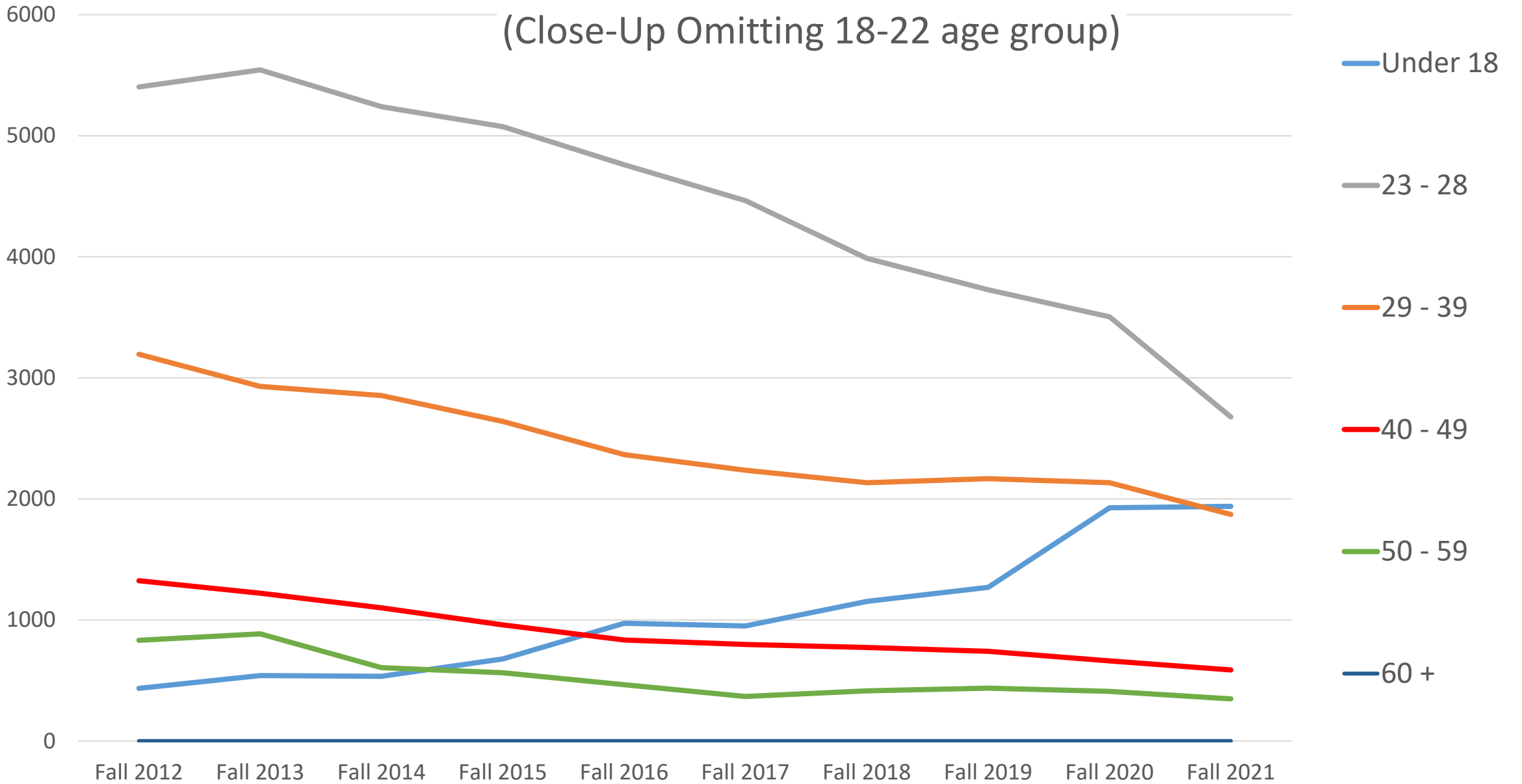

# Socio Economic Status/ Low Income

Socio Economic Status information limited to Low-Income/ Non-Low Income

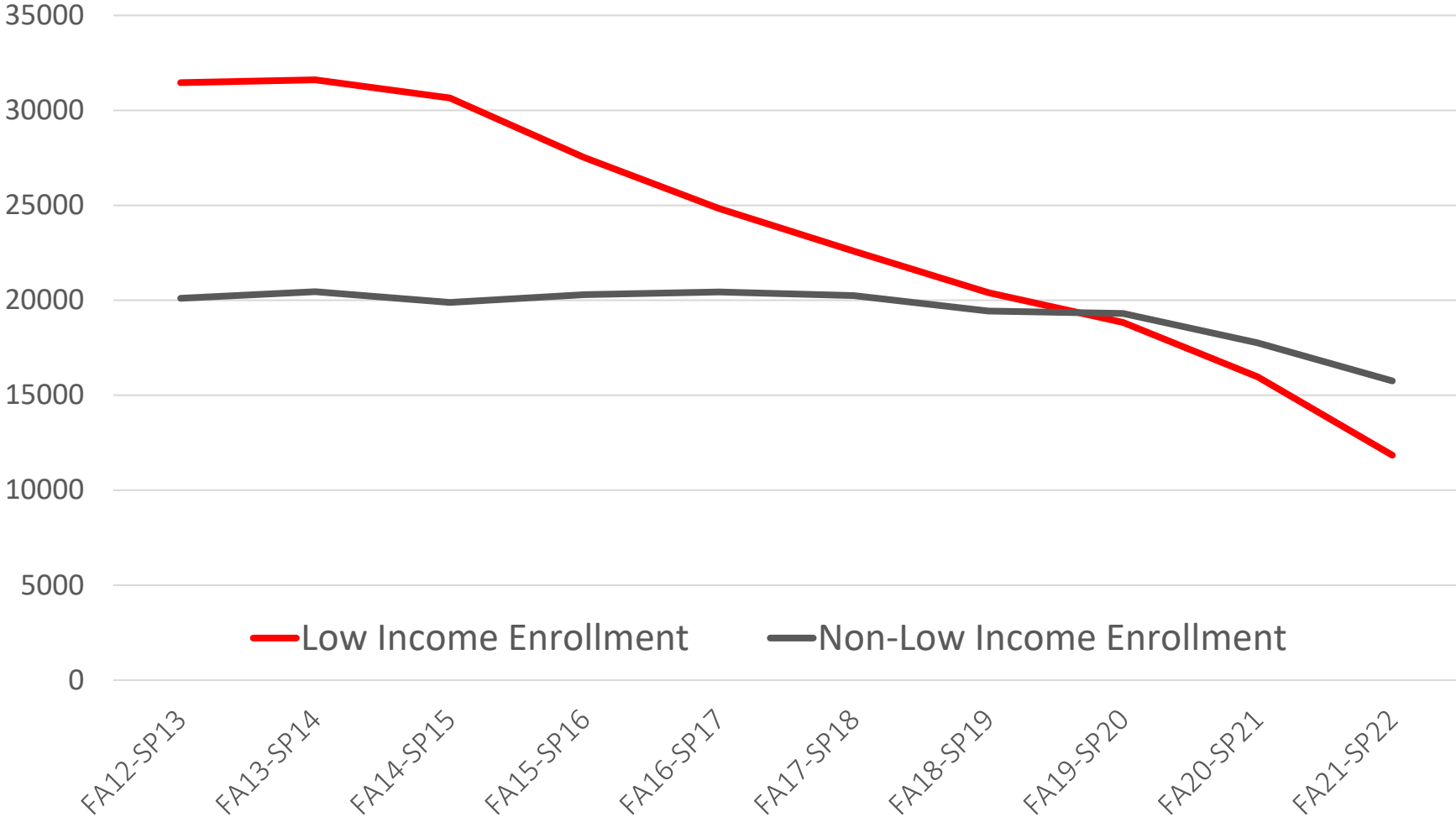
**A student is designated as “low income” if they received any need-based financial aid during any term enrolled at an SMCCCD College.**

*(FinAid Fund Codes 'BA1','BA2','BA','BAX','BBI','BBX','BWA','BWB','BWI','CARE','CHAFG','PELL','SEOG')*

**All other students are designated “Non-Low Income”**

High School and International students are not eligible for aid, so they are omitted.
