Our Filipino Cultural Night (PCN) Production this year will be happening on April 18th and 20th, in Skyline College's Theater. The PCN production is an annual tradition here at Skyline College. This year will mark the 14th production and the last to be held on campus until the opening of the new theater space. Filipino/Filipino Americans represent one of the largest ethnic groups on campus, making up about 17% of the Skyline student body. PCN is created and lead by Skyline's Filipino Student Union (FSU) and students in the Kababayan Learning Community (KLC) who want to share with the Skyline community what it means to be Filipino/ Filipino American. PCN aims to teach all Skyline students about the rich Filipino/Filipino American culture, heritage, and history through an engaging play that features cultural music and dance, Filipino/ Filipino American community issues, and hopes to inspire the community to understand the complexity of Filipino/Filipino American identity.

These programs will be used as a recruitment and retainment for future Skyline students, as teaching tools in KLC classes, and as historical documentation for this year's KLC 15th year anniversary gala and future celebrations.
