Friday, April 7th	Packets DUE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Final deadline to be considered a candidate to run for office. • Those who failed to turn in their packet on time will not have their name placed on the ballot.
Monday, April 10 TO Thursday, April 13th from 12PM to 1PM	Meet Your Candidates Day	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All students running for office (of whom turned in a packet) should be present at this event • Each candidate shall have a spot at a 6-foot table provided by the Center for Student Life - this may be in the Quad or inside of Building 6 (Fireside Dining Area) <u>*location to be announced</u> • Candidates must be able to meet & greet students & talk to them about voting the next week
Monday, April 17th to Thursday, April 20th	Election Polls OPEN: Voting by NoviSurvey sent to all registered Skyline College students	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ballots to go out electronically to each registered student via my.smccd email • Students may vote ONLY once • All students who vote are entered into a drawing in which their G # MAY be chosen at random (lottery) to win Apple product prizes given by the ASSC.
Friday, April 21st	Center for Student Life to announce new ASSC Officers for 2022-2023	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Results to be reviewed by the Center for Student Life Staff. • Election results to be posted on the ASSC website and ASSC social media after 12PM on 4/22 • If there are discrepancies in any data, Student Life reserves the right to post results by Monday, 4/25 at the latest. As always, these dates are subject to change based on availability or other circumstances.

*Campaigning may take place by social media (Facebook, Instagram or TikTok) but MUST first be screened by the Center for Student Life to check if content is appropriate and follows Skyline College Marketing (MCPR) guidelines. Candidates must send in their images/posts via email to samnr@my.smccd.edu - once content is approved, the Student Life office will send candidates a confirmation that they may then post/share to social media. Candidates may also create a free Adobe Spark Page to showcase themselves as a candidate for specific positions.

*In light of COVID-19 & our elections taking place entirely online, the ASSC will no longer enforce these former guidelines:

- The 25 signatures & endorsements from peers
- Attending an ASSC Meeting
- The mandatory in-person debate that usually occurs right after packets are due

*Candidates are still required to turn in packets by 4/7, attend the Meet Your Candidates Day & also send a headshot of themselves (fully clothed, appropriate shot used for the ballot) - photo must be in HD or clear enough quality.
