	<p>Meet all the following ASSC Constitution Requirements for Candidates below:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be enrolled in at least 6 units for Fall 2024 & 6 units in Spring 2025 semesters. • Upon filing to run for an office you must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 to hold a Senator position and 2.5 to hold an Executive Council position. Candidates must be verified to be in good standing at the college. • Be ready to attend mandatory training after assuming office. • Must have read and have knowledge of the ASSC Constitution and Bylaws. • Must attend and observe at least one ASSC meeting prior to the election. • A candidate running for the office of President or Vice President must meet the following requirements: successful completion of 8 units of college level courses & an accumulative of GPA 2.75 • Must also maintain a “satisfactory progress” defined as 50% or higher completion rate.
