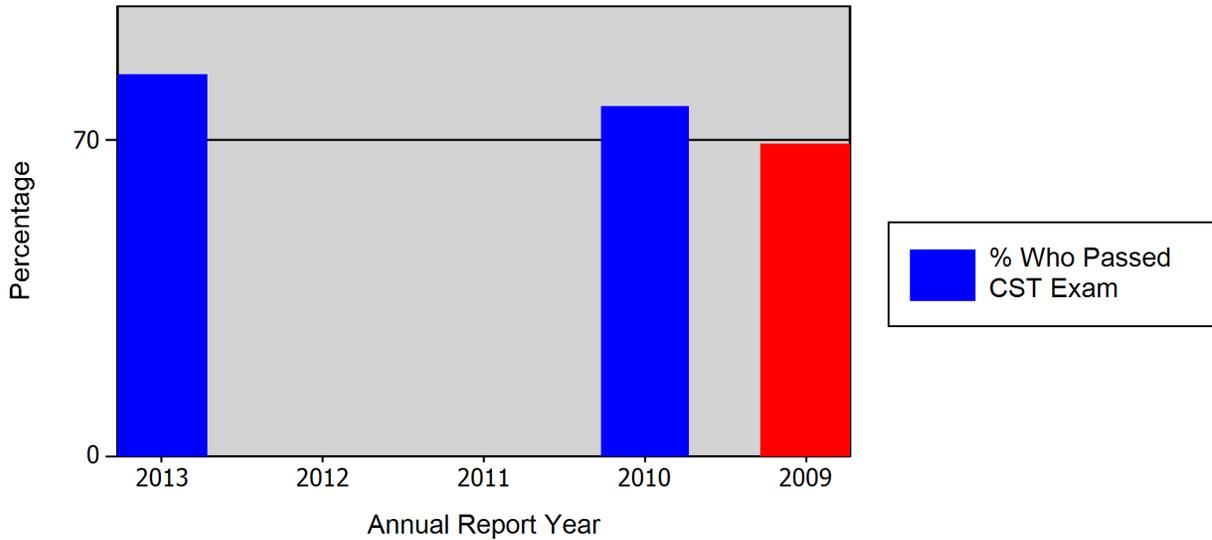

This is due to the economic downturn and the fact that many staff members of retirement age were choosing not to retire.

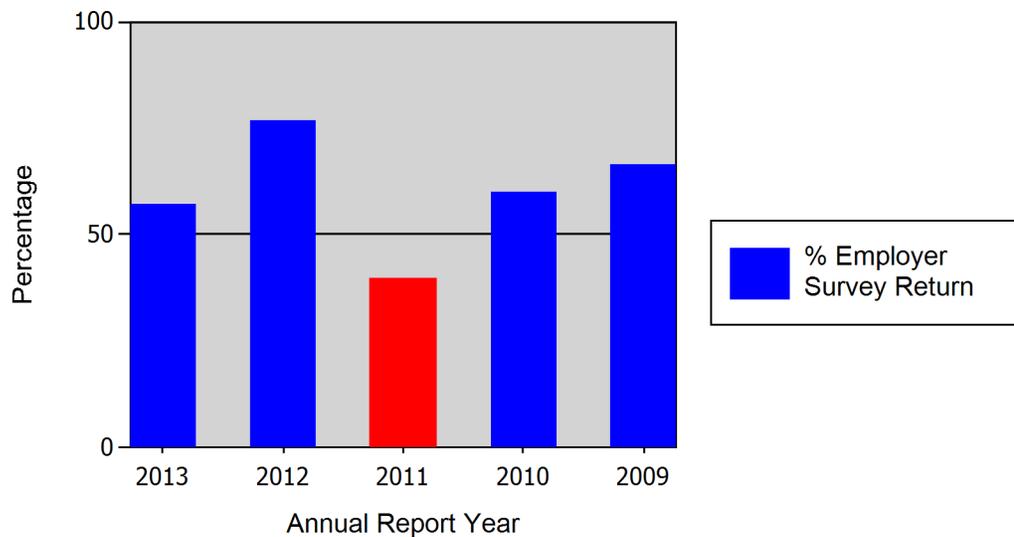

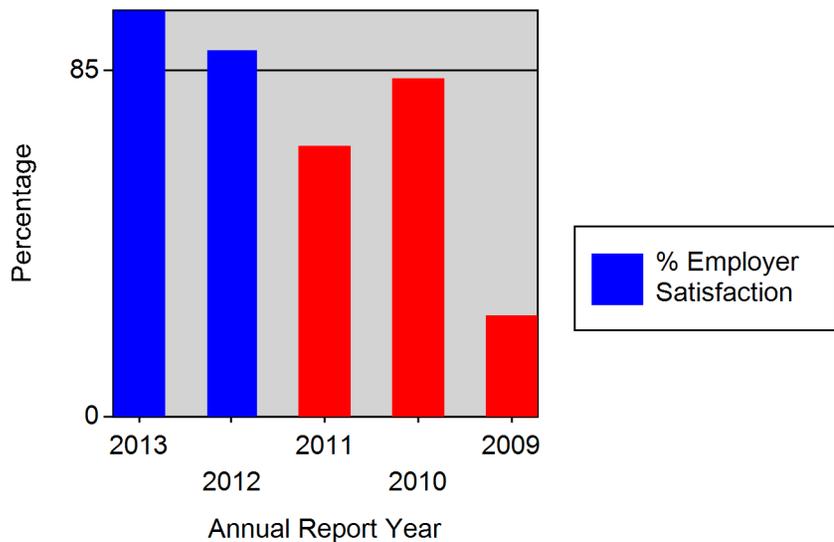

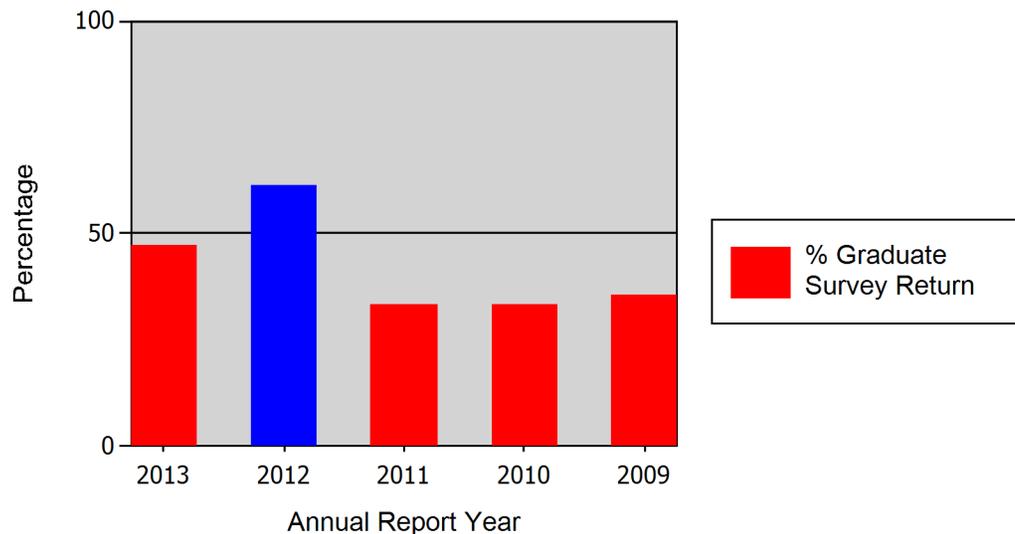

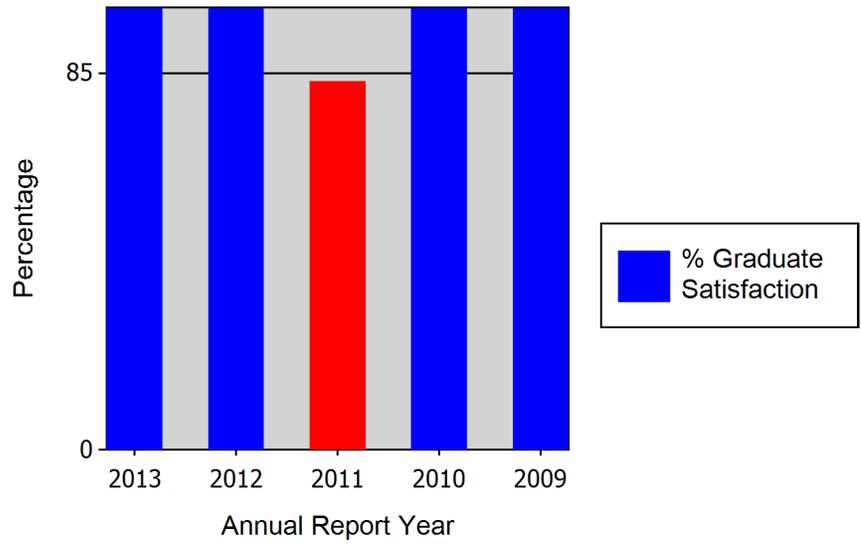
