**TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR TRANSFER AS A JUNIOR TO A CSU CAMPUS, YOU MUST:**

- Complete at least 60 CSU transferable units with a "C" average (2.0)
- Complete at least 30 of the 39 units from the GE courses listed below, including one course from each of the following areas: **A1, A2, A3, and B4** with grades of "C-" or higher. Please be aware that for some campuses and majors, you may not complete Areas A1, A2, A3, and B4 during your last term prior to enrolling at a CSU campus. Please see counselor for specifics.
- While a course may be listed in more than one area, it may be used to satisfy only ONE subject requirement.
